### **Significant Issues:**

The SEOC has been in contact with the Northwest Arctic Borough and City of Kotzebue regarding two days of recent seasonal flooding and resulting road erosion in the community. The city is working with DOT&PF and the Native Tribe to place gravel on eroded areas to two roads. There are no immediate unmet needs nor requests for assistance at this time. SEOC will continue to monitor.

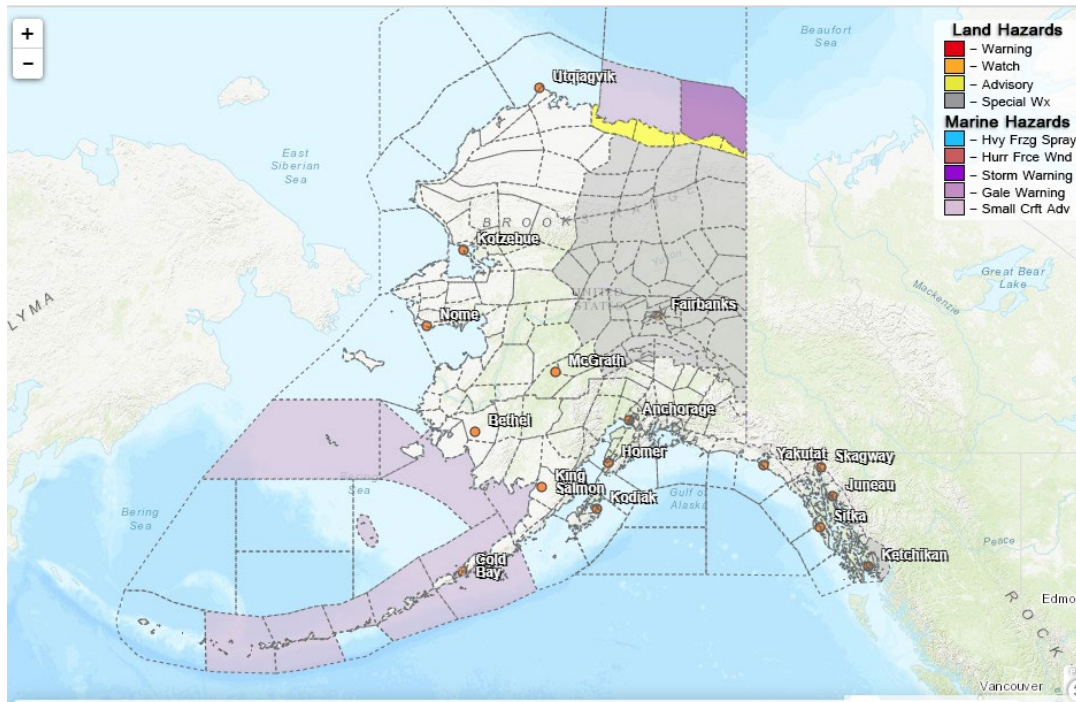
