**Significant Issues:**

**Heavy Rains, Winds – Southcentral and Prince William Sound:**

The Alaska State Emergency Operations Center is closely monitoring heavy rains and winds occurring over Southcentral and Prince William Sound areas of the State.

Last night the Red Cross and Municipality of Anchorage Emergency Operations Center notified SEOC of a localized landslide impacting an apartment complex on Arctic Blvd. in Anchorage, requiring the overnight sheltering of some residents. No State assistance was requested.

SEOC has also been in contact with Emergency Management in Cordova, Kenai Peninsula Borough, and Valdez concerning the National Weather Service's ongoing flood watches and warnings, but there are no reports of serious impacts at this time.

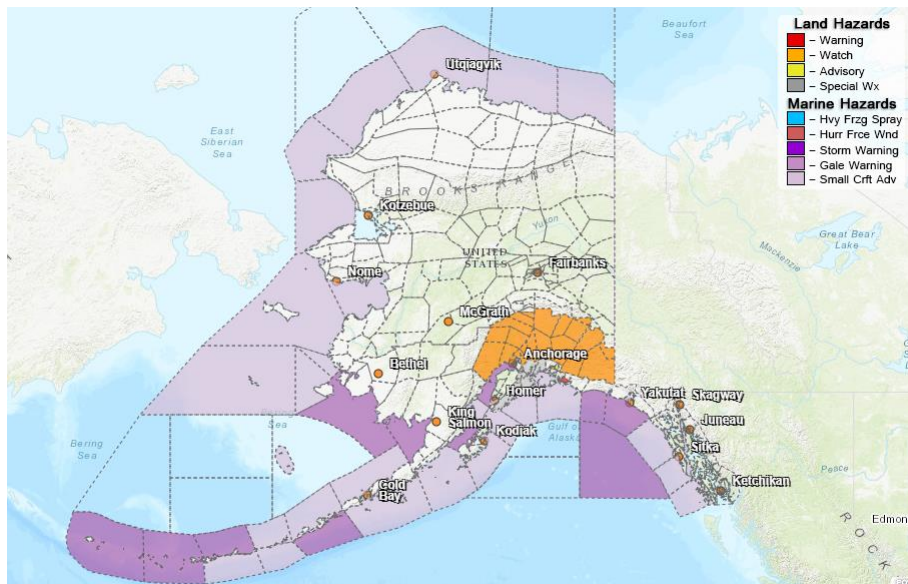
