**Significant Issues:**

SEOC has moved to Level 2 – Heightened Awareness as September Storm operations transition to State/FEMA Joint Field Office.

**September Major Coastal Sea Storm**

Incident operations are transitioning from response in the SEOC to recovery coordinated through the State/FEMA Joint Field Office.

**October Major Coastal Sea Storm:**

The SEOC, along with NWS, FEMA, and our agency and VOAD partners, continue to monitor impacts from a strong coastal sea storm that impacted the Northwest Arctic and North Slope Boroughs over the past several days. The North Slope Borough and the Inupiat Community of the Arctic Slope (ICAS) have each declared local emergency on October 7, 2022, but neither declaration has requested state assistance.

The DOH is leading the State of Alaska COVID-19 Recovery, supported by the SEOC and other state departments as required.

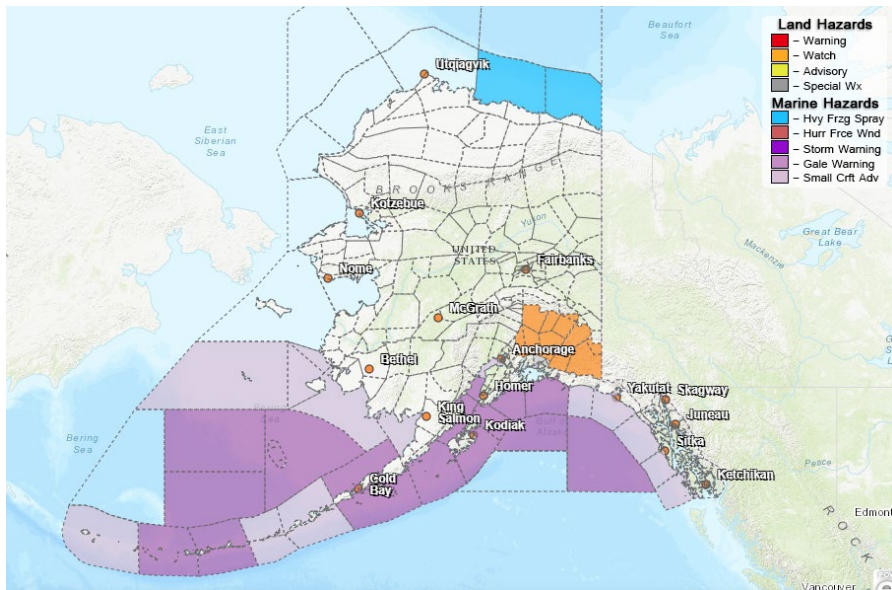

### **Significant Weather:**



The following weather watches, warnings, or advisories have been issued:

- Winter storm watch in effect from Saturday morning through Sunday morning for the Copper River Basin. Heavy mixed precipitation possible. Total snow accumulations of 1 to 4 inches and ice accumulations up to a quarter of an inch possible.
- Wintry mix of precipitation possible Saturday morning for Northeast Prince William Sound. Any snow is expected to changeover to a wintry mix of snow, sleet, and freezing rain before changing over to all rain later Saturday morning.
