- Winter weather advisory in effect until 10:00AM this morning for Haines Borough and Klukwan. Snow expected with accumulation of 3 – 5 inches.
- Winter storm warning in effect until 10:00PM this evening for Municipality of Skagway. Heavy snow expected with accumulation of 6 11 inches expected.
- Winter weather advisory in effect until 1:00PM this afternoon for Thompson Pass. Blowing snow with gusts up to 40 mph.
- High wind warning in effect until 4:00PM for the Alaska Peninsula, including Cold Bay.
   Northwest winds 40 to 50 mph with gusts up to 85 mph expected.
