

Significant Weather:




Blizzard Warning for St. Lawrence Island and the Bering Strait Coast including Wales until 3:00 pm Sunday.

- Areas near Haines have a moderate advisory level above 1,500 ft.
- Areas near Cordova have a moderate advisory level above 1,000 ft.

- Hatcher Pass has a moderate advisory above 2,500 ft.
