# **Significant Issues:**

## Juneau Suicide Basin Flooding:

A joint State/Federal Emergency Management Agency Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA) is underway in Juneau in coordination with the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ) to develop damage information and costs to support consideration of a request for federal assistance. The assessment is expected to be completed today and the PDA group demobilized along with the SEOC CBJ Branch Director as the disaster response transitions to recovery operations.


