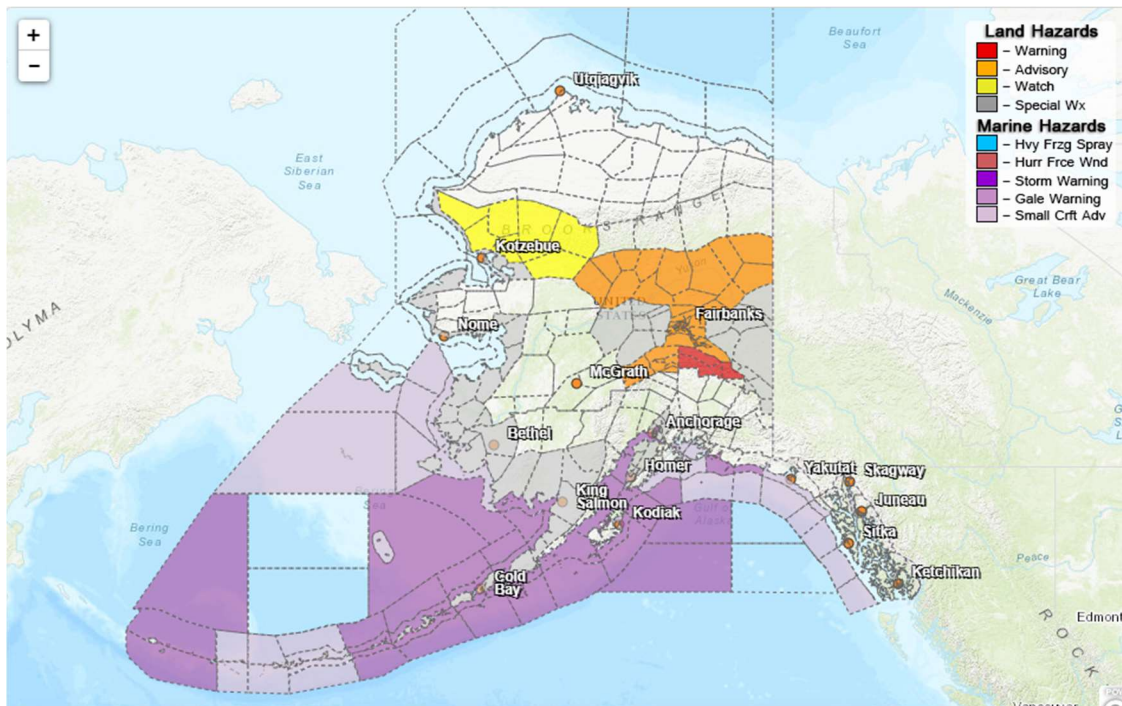

The following Warnings, Watches, and/or Advisories have been issued:

### **Dense Fog Advisory:**

- Middle Tanana Valley – in effect until 10 AM AKDT this morning.

**Flood Watch:**

- Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys; Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys; Upper Koyukuk Valley – in effect through Friday Morning.

**Flood Advisory:**

- Middle Tanana Valley; Deltana and Tanana Flats – in effect until noon AKDT Saturday.

**Wind Advisory:**

- Denali – in effect from 10 AM AKDT today to 4 AM AKDT Friday.
- Deltana and Tanana Flats – in effect from Noon today to 10 AM AKDT Friday.
- Yukon Flats and Surrounding Uplands – in effect from 10 AM Friday to 4 PM AKDT Saturday.
- Upper Koyukuk Valley – in effect from 1 PM Friday to 7 AM AKDT Saturday.

**High Wind Warning:**

- Eastern Alaska Range – in effect from Noon today through Friday morning.

**Special Weather Statement:**

- Central Interior; Deltana and Tanana Flats; Upper Tanana Valley and the Fortymile Country; Denali; Eastern Alaska Range – High water on the Tanana River and Tributaries draining the Alaska Range into the weekend.
- Kuskokwim Delta; Bristol Bay – Gusty winds and high waves expected tonight through Friday.
- Alaska Peninsula; Eastern Aleutians; Central Aleutians – Strong winds, high waves, and moderate to heavy rain expected through today.
- Chukchi Sea Coast; Baldwin Peninsula and Selawik Valley; Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast; Yukon Delta – Elevated surf Friday and Friday night.
- Matanuska Valley – Strong winds in the Palmer Area today.
- Anchorage – Strong winds in the Anchorage Area late this morning into Friday.
- Western Kenai Peninsula – Undefined.
