Significant Issues:

An ash cloud from Shishaldin Volcano reaching 40,000 ft (12 km) above sea level was observed in satellite data. Aviation Color Code is being raised to **RED** and the Volcano Alert Level is being raised to **WARNING**. Ashfall is possible for the community of False Pass in trace amounts.



Special Weather Statement:

As of 1400Z or 6:00 AM AKDT Tuesday morning, satellite imagery detected an ongoing eruption of Shishaldin. Ash is being lofted up to 40,000 ft over Unimak Island with the plume moving to the south and west. Trace amounts of ashfall are possible for the community of False Pass.
