## Significant Weather:



#### **Special weather statement:**

Snow through Thursday with freezing rain possible today for Point Lay to Umiat and Happy Valley south into the Brooks Range, including Central Brooks Range and Arctic Plains. The freezing rain threat should end by this evening. Kaktovik will see winds up to 30 mph with blowing snow and reduced visibility from late tonight through Wednesday night.

Snow and periods of light freezing rain are possible today into tonight for the Central Interior South Dalton Highway Summits including North and South Denali Borough. Snow and freezing rain will occur north and west of Livengood. Most areas will see just a trace amount of snow, but areas north of the Yukon River could get an inch or two of snow through tonight.

Rain and snow with patchy freezing rain are occurring across much of the West Coast and Western Interior northeast of McGrath and Kotzebue. This mixed precipitation will continue today, with the precipitation tapering off tonight.
