Wrangell Landside Disaster:

Selawik Power Outage:

The SEOC and the Northwest Arctic Borough continue to work with the community to address needs.

Point Hope Power Outage:

SEOC is actively monitoring Point Hope's response with community officials and the North Slope Borough.

Manokotak Power Outage:

SEOC is actively monitoring progress with community officials, AEA and mass care partners.

Savoonga Power Outage:

A local damage assessment is ongoing for possible loss of food. Several home heating units are enroute.
