Significant Issues:

Severed Offshore Internet Cable – Utqiagvik

SEOC was in contact with the Inupiat Community of the Arctic Slope (ICAS) regarding the communications disruption and provided ICAS Emergency Management with a potential vendor for alternate communications support during the disruption. SEOC received an inquiry from FEMA about 911 disruptions in the area and confirmed Borough and Public Safety Answering Point for the area are aware and addressing with alternate methods. SEOC worked with State Department of Health to provide suggestions for alternative communications to health care facilities in the disruption area. The State Office of Information Technology is procuring alternate communications devices to support State of Alaska government communications in areas affected by the disruption.

2023 Spring Floods Disaster

Disaster Mass Care, Individual Assistance, and Public Assistance support continues for communities impacted by flooding. State Individual Assistance payments are being distributed to survivors. Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is actively working on flood impacted roadways in multiple areas including the Dalton and Elliot Highways, but work is challenged by severe ongoing flooding with some lane restrictions in place. SEOC is preparing for joint Preliminary Damage Assessments with the Federal Emergency Management Agency. SEOC deployed a State Public Assistance specialist to Crooked Creek to assess damages.
