Significant Issues:

The SEOC preparedness level has returned to Level 1 due to the stabilization of multiple community utility events.

Wrangell Landside Disaster:

Quinhagak Power Outage Disaster:

Hughes Water Break:

The SEOC was notified that the community has sustained breaks in both the main and school water lines late Friday afternoon. Throughout the weekend, the SEOC has engaged ANTHC, DEC and DOH and a Remote Maintenance Worker (RMW) will be sent to the community today to repair them, weather depending. The SEOC will continue to monitor the situation and stands ready to assist with mass care needs and support if needed.

Cold Bay Power Outage:

The community suffered a power disruption to several structures over the weekend. The fire department, DOT/PF shop, and lodge all have power, so no life-safety concerns were identified. The city is going to attempt repairs during daylight hours. The SEOC will continue to monitor the community and engage if any assistance is needed.




Avalanche Hazards:
