**Significant Issues:**

**Kotzebue – Frozen Water Lines**

SEOC received a local disaster declaration from Kotzebue. SEOC is closely monitoring emerging events and remains in open communication.

**Koyukuk – Freeze Up**

The Salvation Army, Red Cross Alaska, and Tanana Chiefs Conference in coordination with Everts Air and Wright Air have delivered the anticipated water and food to Koyukuk. Permanent repairs to the water plant pump are expected to take up to eight weeks. TCC RMW is continuing to work with the power plant operator on a temporary, partial repair/plan until ordered parts arrive. SEOC is continuing to monitor the situation.

**Chalkyitsik – Power Outage**

The Tanana Chiefs Conference (TCC) was able to get their contracted technician back into the community yesterday and the power was restored. SEOC remains in open communication with the community and the agencies involved.

**Quinhagak Power Outage Disaster**

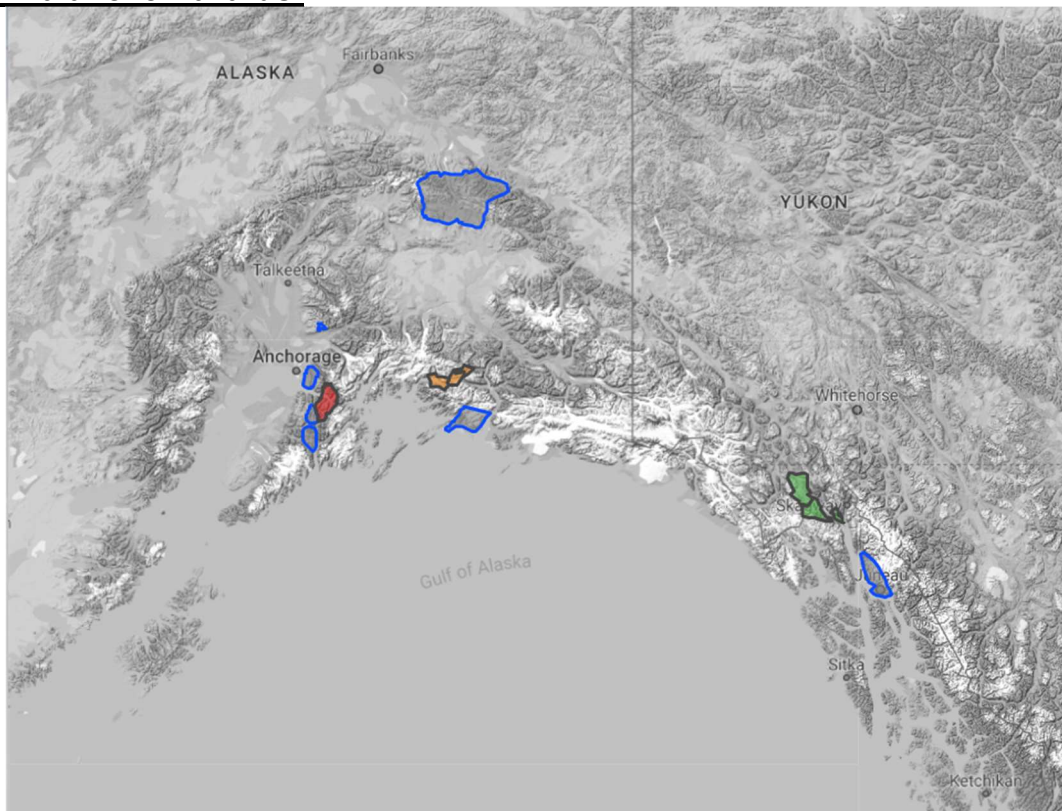

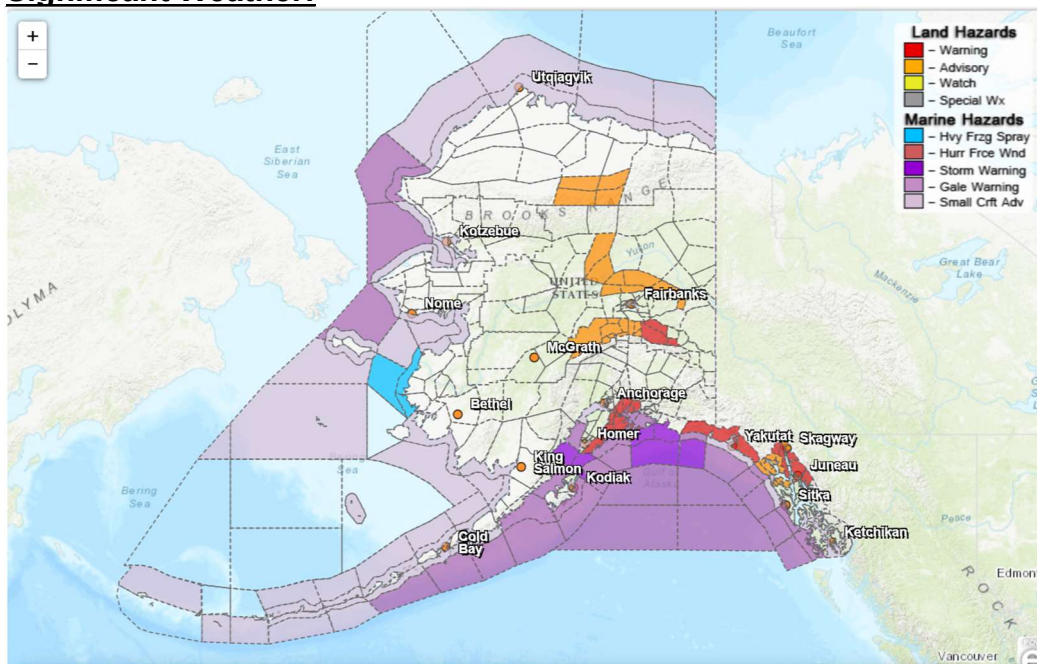
## Avalanche Hazards:
