



State Disaster Assistance

For Individuals and families with temporary housing needs, damaged primary residences, or essential personal property lost from the 2022 Spring Floods.

Residents of the Yukon – Koyukuk Regional Education Attendance Area (REAA) including the community of Manley Hot Springs, the Kuspuk REAA (Village of Sleetmute and the Village of Red Devil), the Copper River REAA (Glennallen), and the Iditarod REAA (City of McGrath), are eligible to apply for State Individual Assistance.

- Description of damages and/or losses
- Home ownership documentation
 - Insurance information
 - Personal identification
- Proof of occupancy (utility bill)

2022 Spring Flood survivors are strongly encouraged to apply for individual assistance as soon as possible.

The deadline to apply for individual assistance is July 12, 2021
