Incident Overview

State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) Activated to Level 2

Riverwatch 2018 began on 4/30/2018 with the SEOC standing up to a Level 2 Preparedness Level. Riverwatch Upper Kuskokwim Division demobilized on the evening of 5/4/2018.

Kuskokwim Division Interagency Coordination from SEOC:

Nuisance flooding began in Tuluksak around 0100 on 5/8/2018 due to an ice jam forming a few miles downriver. A flood warning was issued but then cancelled based upon aerial reconnaissance and river observations.

Upper Yukon Division:

Daily flights monitoring river ice status between Eagle and Circle. As of 1200 5/8/2018 ice began moving near Eagle and Dawson.
