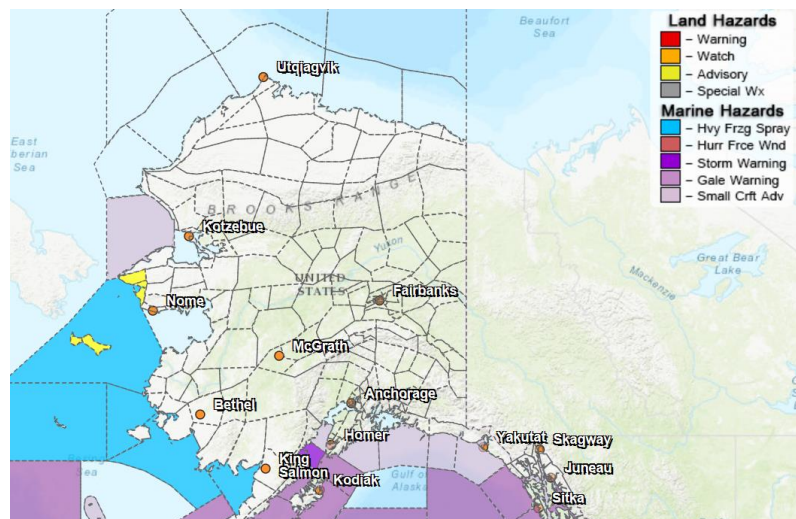
Cook Inlet Earthquake

The SEOC continues to be activated to Level 3 in response to the M7.0 earthquake affecting the Municipality of Anchorage, Matanuska-Susitna Borough, and Kenai Peninsula Borough last Friday. Joint FEMA/State/local government preliminary damage assessment teams worked in the Anchorage and Mat Su areas today.

Diomedes Power Outage

Alaska Energy Authority reports power was restored to Diomedes last Saturday. However, the Division of Community and Regional Affairs (DCRA) in Kotzebue reports all the local power plant operators and their alternates have resigned. DCRA will approach the community to find a local person to attend an upcoming AEA Power Plant Operator training in Anchorage.
