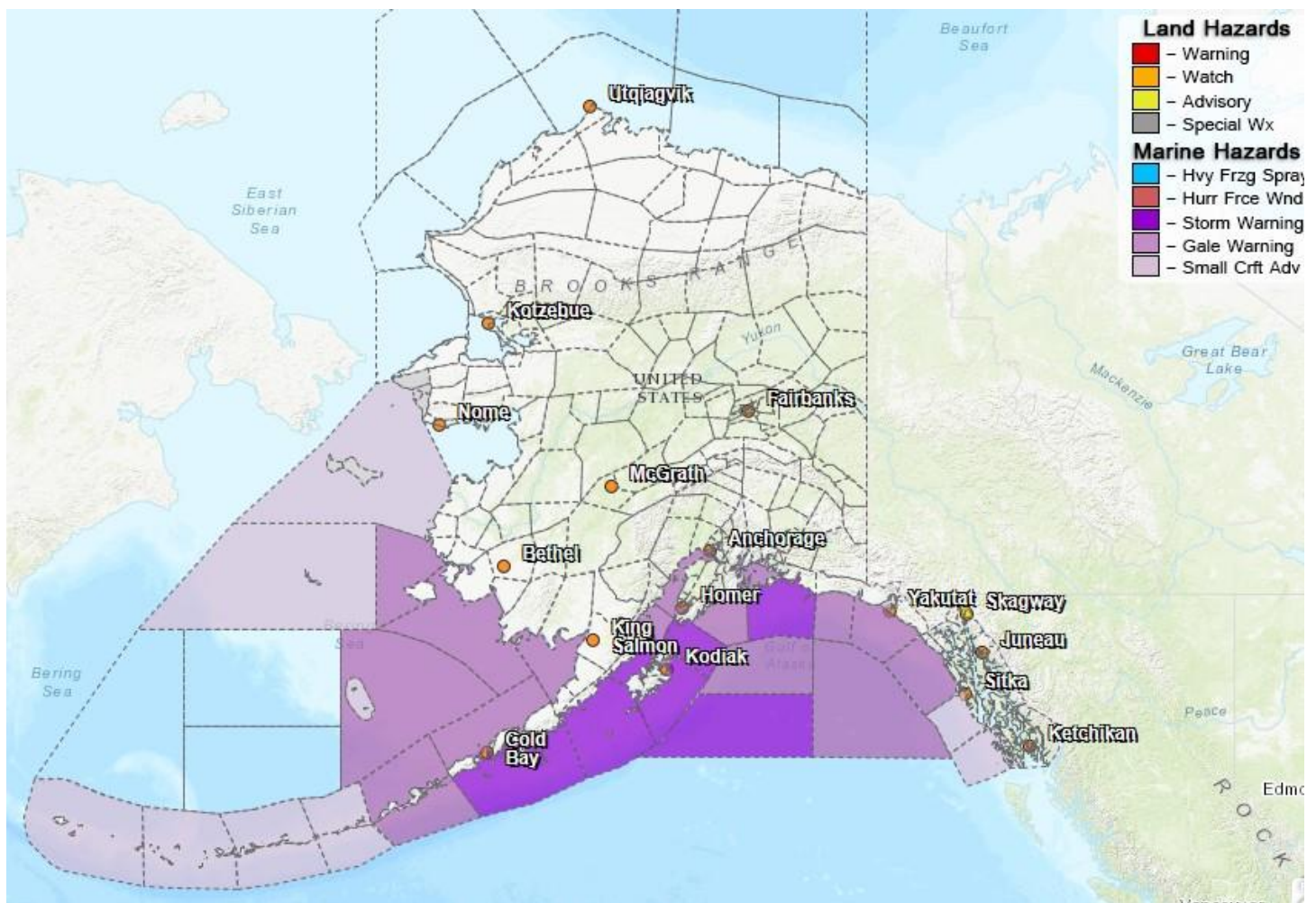

### **Significant Weather:**



A winter weather advisory is issued for Tuesday through the evening of Wednesday for the areas of Taiya Inlet and the Klondike Highway. Four to six inches of heavy, wet snow is expected near White Pass and driving is expected to be hazardous.

Special weather statement for elevated surf Wednesday into Thursday has been issued for the St. Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast. Northeasterly winds with gusts up to 50mph are expected for St Lawrence Island and Diomedede late Wednesday into early Thursday. Residents should move possessions well above the normal high tide line in preparation for this event.
