Matanuska Susitna Borough is issuing an air quality advisory for the Greater Palmer Area until the wind subsides. The area has current dry and cold conditions creating an unhealthy air quality. The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation Division of Air Quality recommends stopping all outdoor burning to include: burn barrels, bonfires, campfire, and fire pits while this advisory is in place.

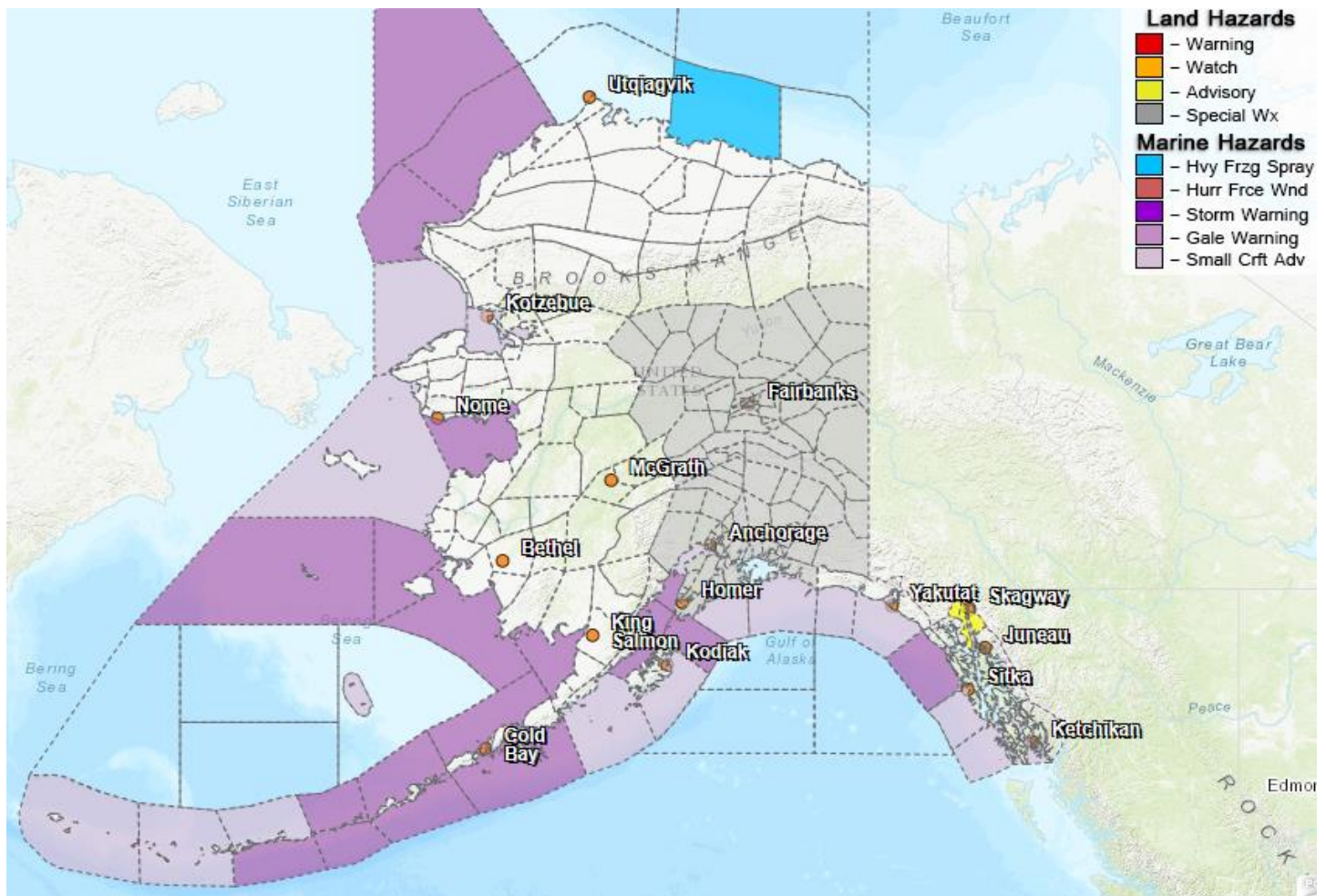

Significant Weather:



A winter weather advisory is in effect for the Haines Borough and Lynn Canal.

A special weather statement has been issued for Anchorage; Copper River Basin; Matanuska Valley; Northeast Prince William Sound; Southeast Prince William Sound; Susitna Valley; Western Kenai Peninsula; and Western Prince William Sound. A winter storm is expected for southcentral

Wednesday and Wednesday night. This will include snow, freezing rain and sleet, along with coastal rains. Areas north of the Kenai Peninsula will see a mix of wintry precipitation and may result in slick driving conditions for the Wednesday evening commute.

A special weather statement has been issued for the Central Interior; Deltana and Tanana Flats; Denali; Eastern Alaska Range; Middle Tanana Valley; Upper Koyukuk Valley; Upper Tanana Valley and the Fortymile Country; Yukon Flats and Surrounding Uplands. Snow and win are expected Tuesday night through Friday. Wind gusts are expected to be 20-35mph with 2-8 inches of snow expected to fall. The combination of wind and cold will produce wind chill to around -30F as well.
