Active Air Advisories are in effect for Fairbanks and North Pole through noon today. Temperature inversion strength causing poor dispersion of burned fuel biproducts.

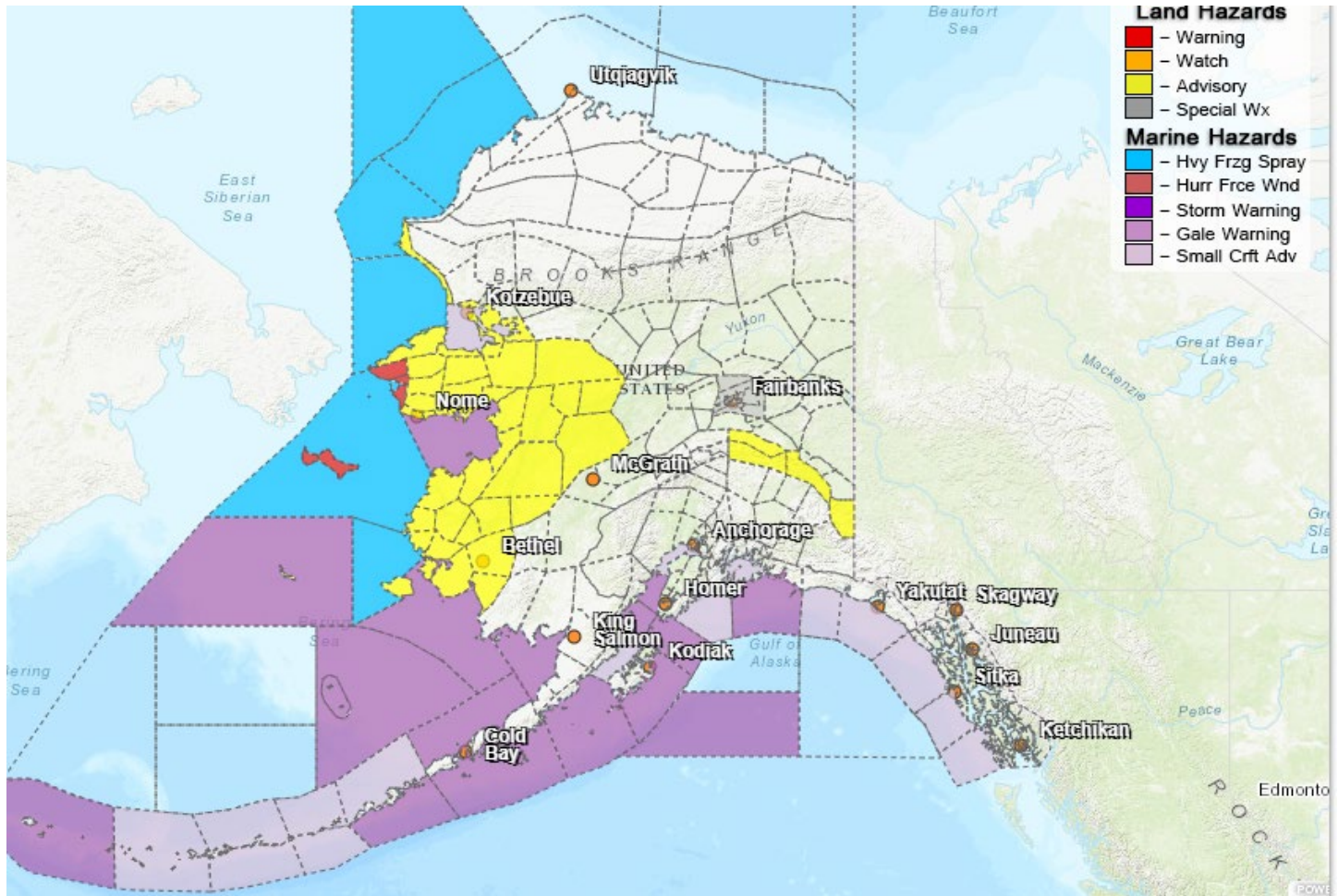

Significant Weather:



A Winter Storm Warning is in effect from 6 pm today until 6 am Sunday morning for heavy snow and blowing snow with winds gusting to 65 mph in St Lawrence Island and the Bering Strait Coast. Damage to power lines is possible.

Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for the Yukon Delta, Lower Yukon Valley, Lower Koyukuk and Middle Yukon Valleys, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Norther and Interior Seward Peninsula, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, the Chukchi Sea Coast and the Baldwin Peninsula and Selawik Valley.

A Wind Advisory is in effect from 9 pm this evening to noon AKST Sunday in the Eastern Alaska Range for South winds 30-45 mph with gusts up to 60 mph expected.
