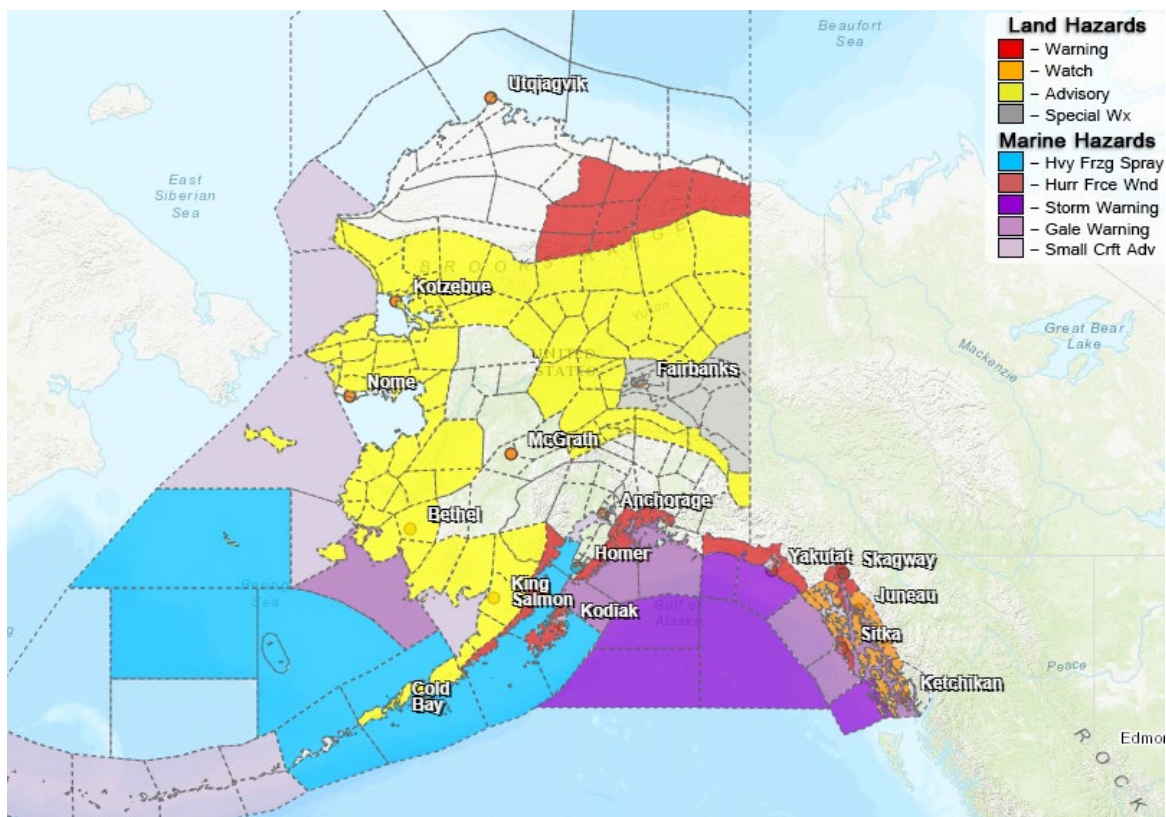

## Significant Weather:



A Special Weather Statement has been issued through 3:00 pm AKST today for snow spreading West across the Eastern Interior.

A Winter Weather Advisory has been Issued for Cape Fairweather to Cape Suckling Coastal Area until 6:00 pm AKST this evening.

A High Wind Warning has been issued for Cape Decision to Salisbury Sound Coastal Area until noon today and a High Wind Watch has been extended for Dixon Entrance to Cape Decision Coastal Area, Inner Channels from Kupreanof Island to Etolin Island, Southern Inner Channels, Juneau Borough and Northern Admiralty Island and Salisburys Sound to Cape Fairweather Coastal Area through 6:00 pm AKST tomorrow.

Blizzard Warnings have been issued to Northeast Prince William Sound and Kodiak Island until 12:00 pm AKST today and for Western Prince William Sound until 4:00 am AKST tomorrow.

Wind Chill Advisories remain in effect through Thursday evening and into Friday morning for much of Alaska with a Wind Chill Warning issued for Northeastern Brooks Range through 6:00 pm Friday evening.

A Winter Storm Warning remains in effect for Taiya Inlet and Klondike Highway, Haines Borough and Lynn Canal, including the cities of Skagway and Haines, until 6:00 pm and a Winter Storm Watch for Eastern Chichagof Island and Glacier Bay through noon tomorrow.
