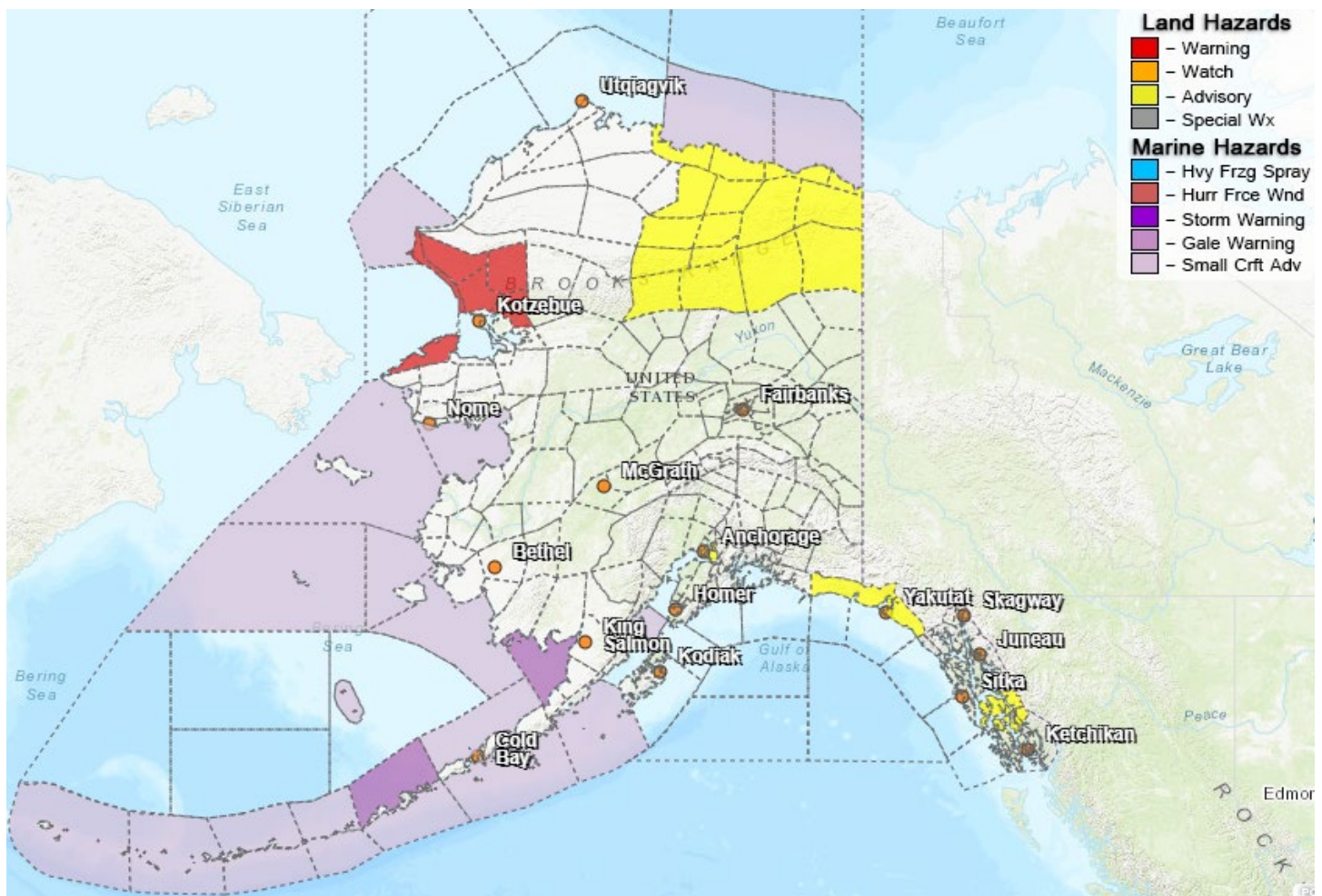

Winter storm warnings are in effect for the Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys and the Chukchi Sea Coast through tomorrow evening.
