A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

**2020 Fire Season**

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 1.

Wildland fire totals for 2020:

Total Fires = 300

Total Acres = 175,521

There are currently 80 active fires with 3 fire currently staffed.

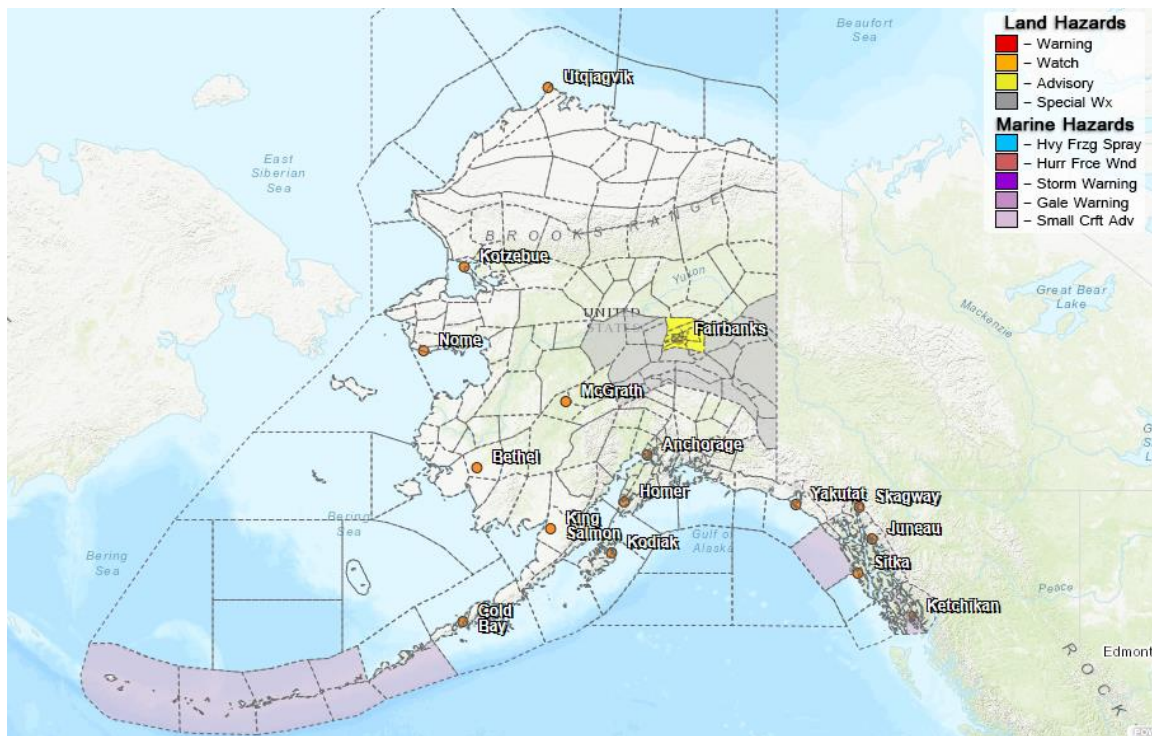

## **Significant Weather:**

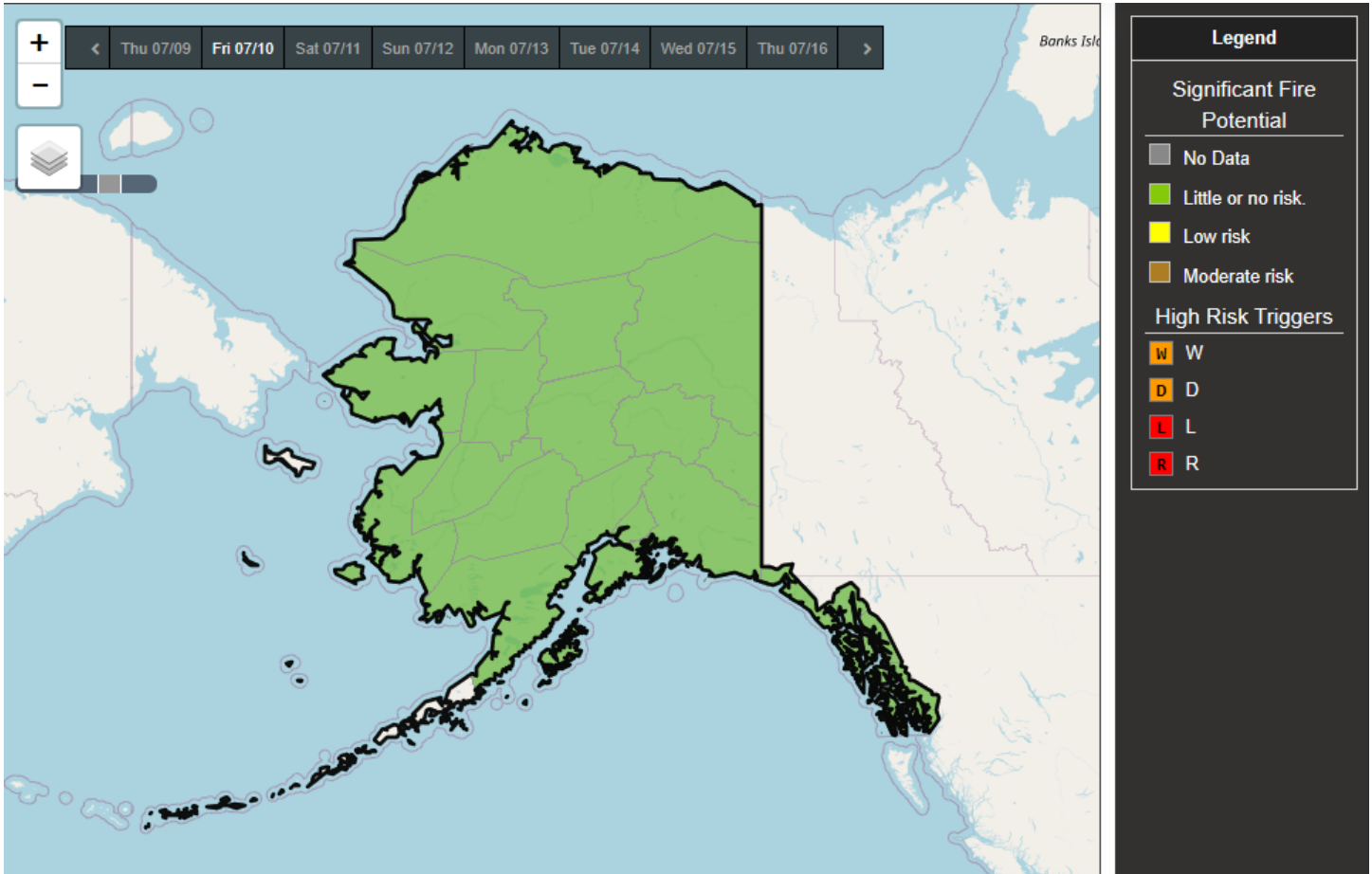


A special weather statement has been issued for heavy rain over the Tanana Valley, heavy rain fell on Thursday and Thursday night across much of the Tanana Valley west of Delta Junction. Most locations had between one quarter and one-half inch, water levels should begin to recede this morning.

Dense fog advisory in effect until 10:00am for the Middle Tanana Valley reducing visibility to one quarter of a mile or less, motorists should drive with caution.
