**Federal Declaration of Disaster for 2022 Spring Flooding**

Following Governor Dunleavy’s declaration of a State Disaster on May 14, 2022 for flooding in Yukon-Koyukuk, Kuspuk, Cooper River, and Iditarod Regional Education Attendance Areas (REAA) and request for Federal assistance, today President Biden declared a Federal Public Assistance disaster for the Kuspuk, Cooper River, and Iditarod REAAs.

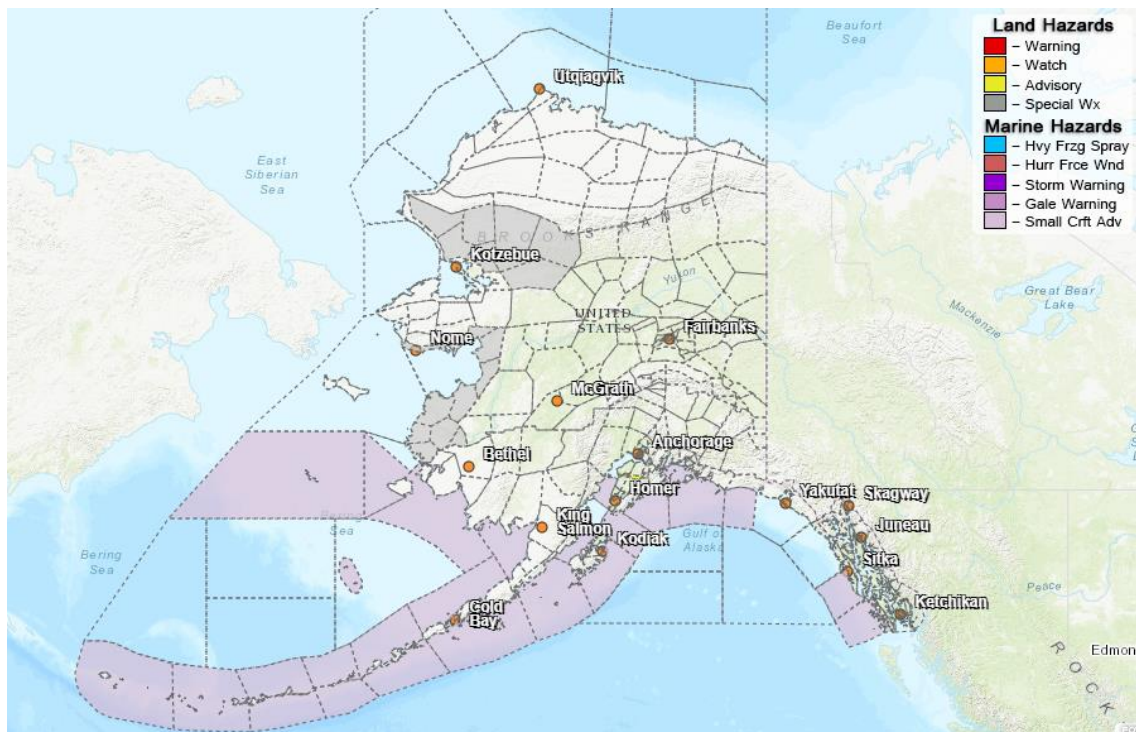

## Significant Weather:



Special Weather Statements have been issued for the following areas:

- Kobuk and Noatak Valleys – Elevated water levels are expected in streams and rivers in the area through the weekend.

- Yukon Delta, Southern Seaward Peninsula Coast and Eastern Norton Sound – Elevated surf levels are expected through this afternoon. Storm surge levels of 2 to 4 feet above the normal high tide line are possible.

A Flood advisory remains in effect for the Western Kenai Peninsula until 5:00 P.M. tomorrow.
