Significant Issues:

Severed Offshore Internet Cable – Utqiagvik

SEOC continues to participate in regular inter-agency coordination calls with the North Slope Borough, North Slope School District, regional tribal organizations, and communications agencies.

The Borough extended their local declaration of disaster emergency for this incident until September 1, 2023.

2023 Spring Floods Disaster

SEOC deployed Disaster Assistance Center teams to Fort Yukon, and Kwethluk yesterday and an additional team to Russian Mission today to provide Individual Assistance registrations, inspections, and review Public Assistance damages in preparation for the joint Preliminary Damage Assessments with the Federal Emergency Management Agency slated for mid-July.

To date the state has received 199 total disaster Individual Assistance registrations. Deadline for Registration is July 23, 2023.

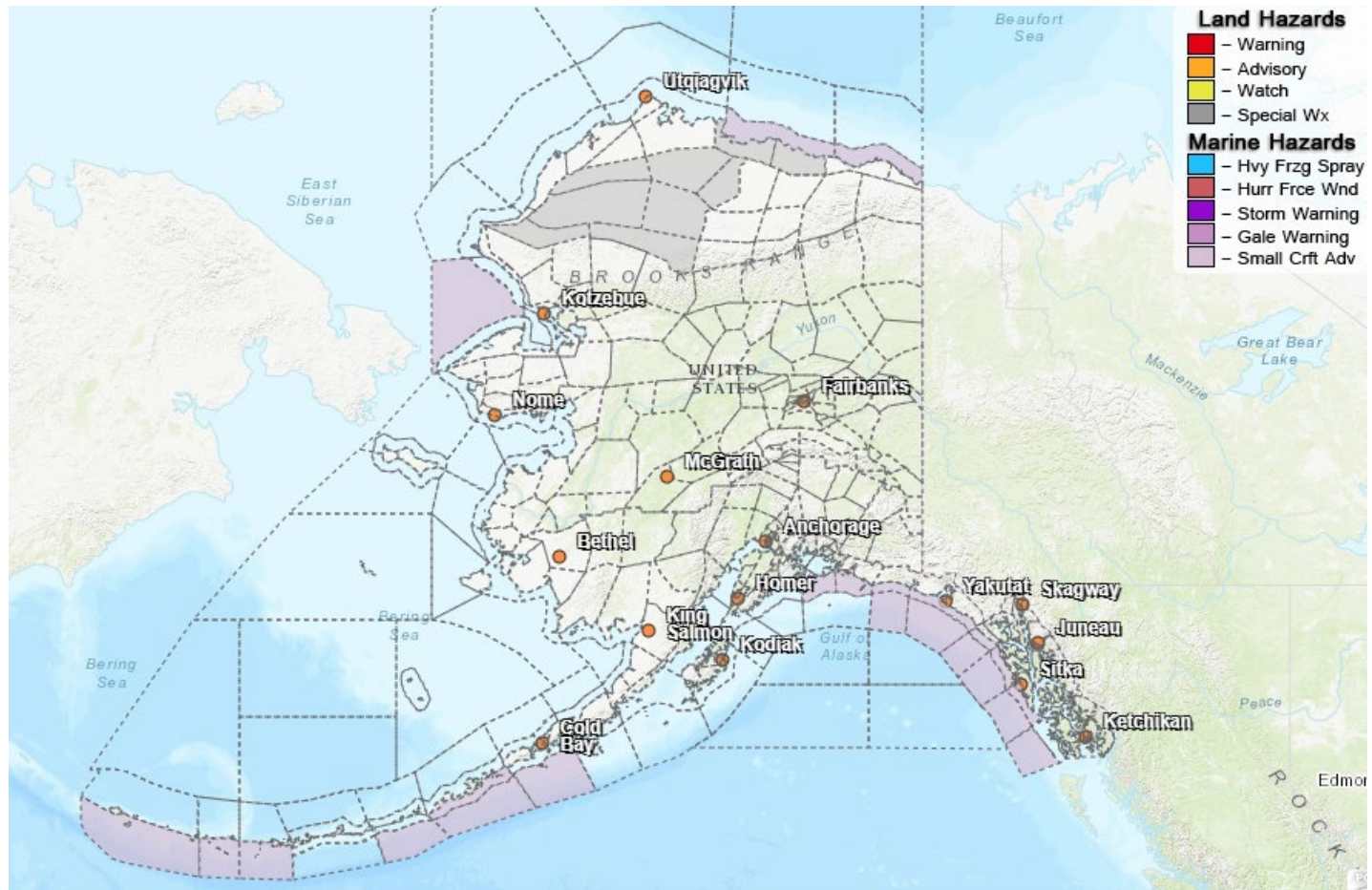
