### **Significant Issues:**

The Alaska Wildland Fire Season is continuing to ramp up across the state, particularly in the Interior. Just under 9,000 acres have burned this week, due to an additional 80 new fires caused by lightning strikes. On the new Teklanika River Fire, a Type II Incident Management Team (IMT) was requested, along with 4 Type I Interagency hotshot teams and several aerial resources to help protect values along the river. 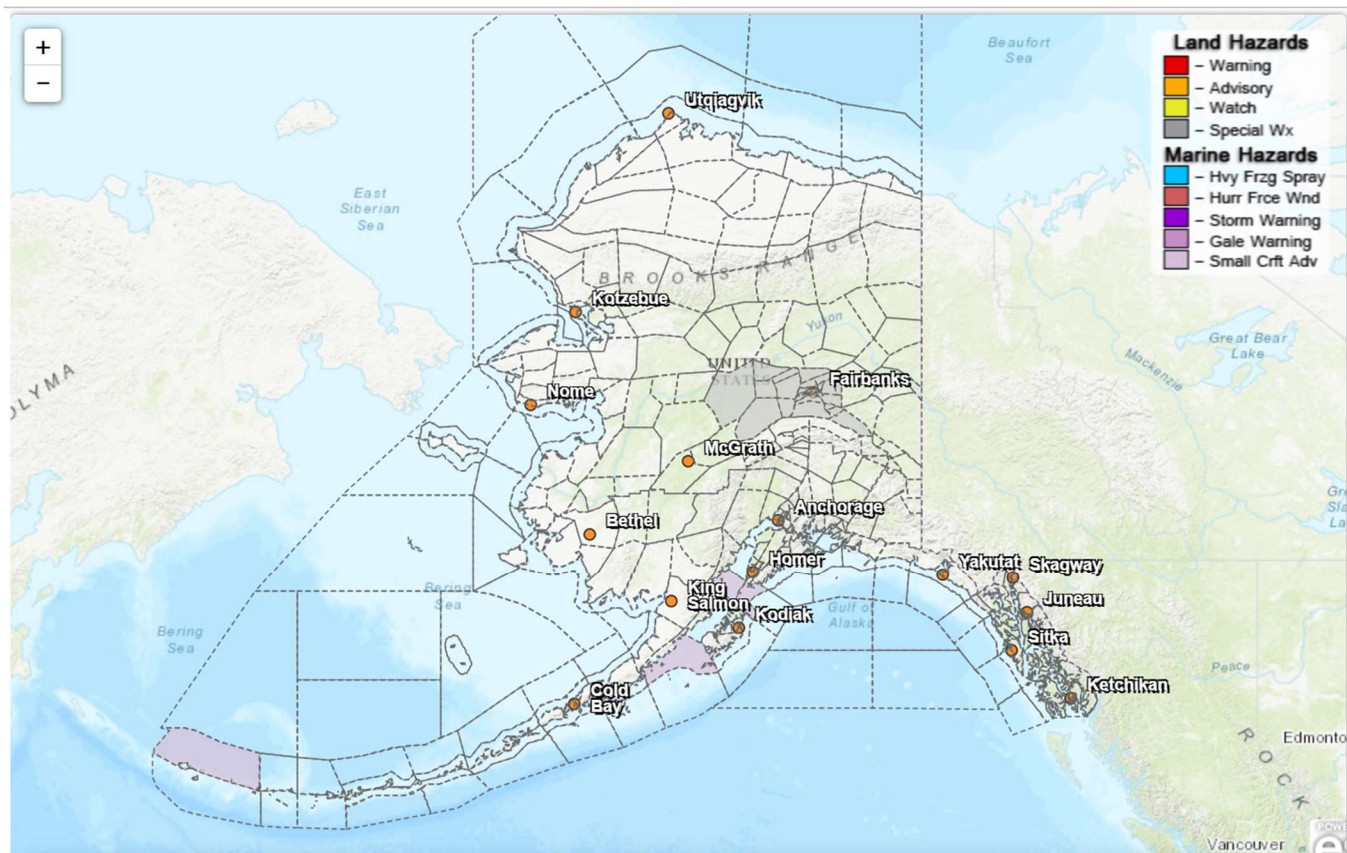
