Chevak – Building Fire

The SEOC will continue to monitor the event.

Mertarvik – Power Outage

SEOC was notified that power was restored to the community but there are reports of a frozen water line. SEOC is coordinating with DEC and the Remote Maintenance Worker program to assist.

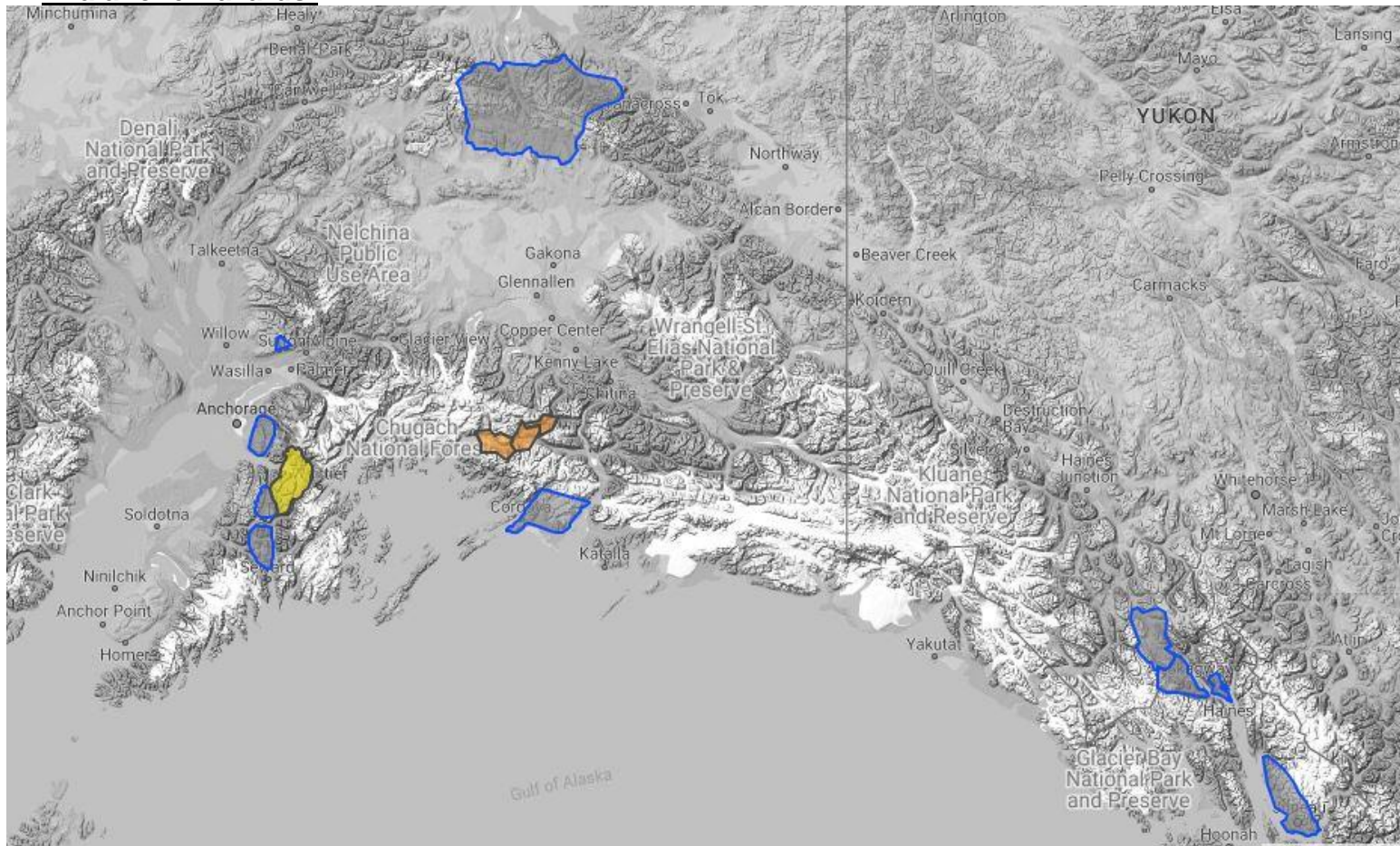

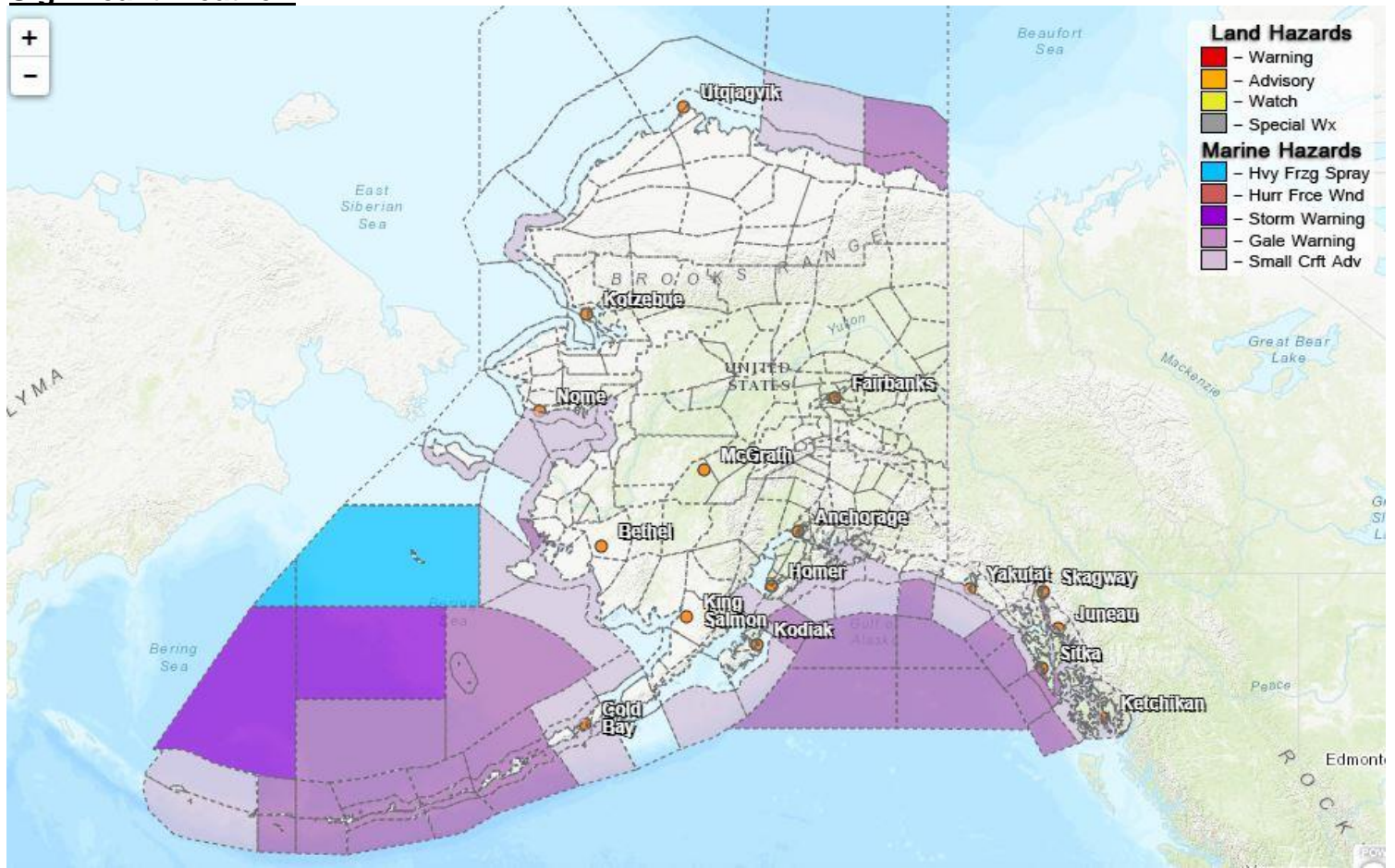
Avalanche Hazards:
