Significant Issues:

Kotzebue – Frozen Water Lines

Yesterday the Governor declared a state disaster in response to the Borough's disaster declaration. SEOC will work with the City of Kotzebue and the Northwest Arctic Borough to implement state disaster recovery programs.

Mertarvik – Frozen Water Lines

SEOC continues to support the community of Mertarvik and the efforts in restoring water lines damaged during an extended power outage through the aid of state and federal agencies, and VOAD partners.

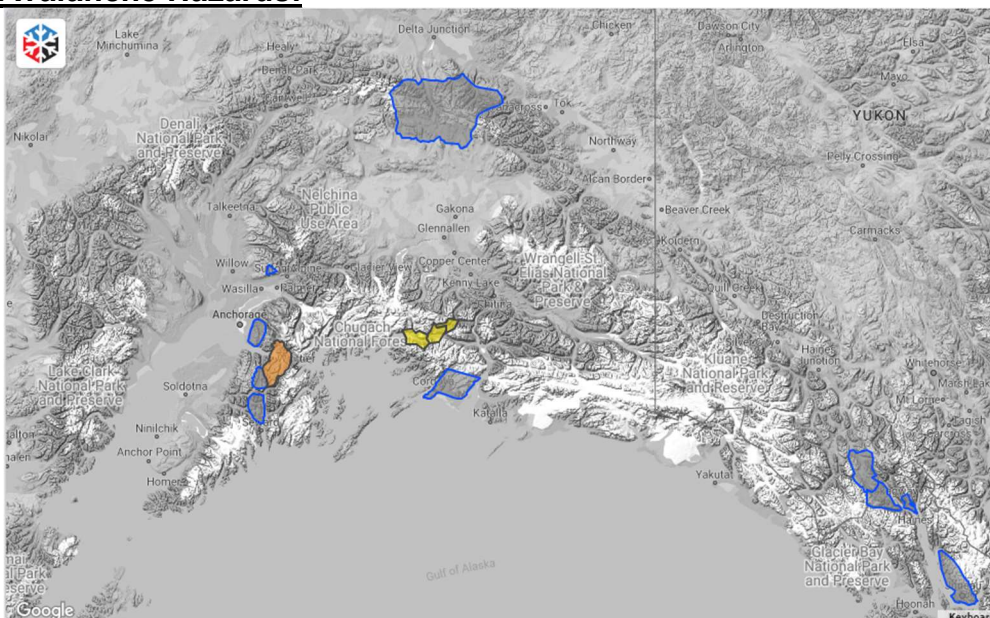

Avalanche Hazards:

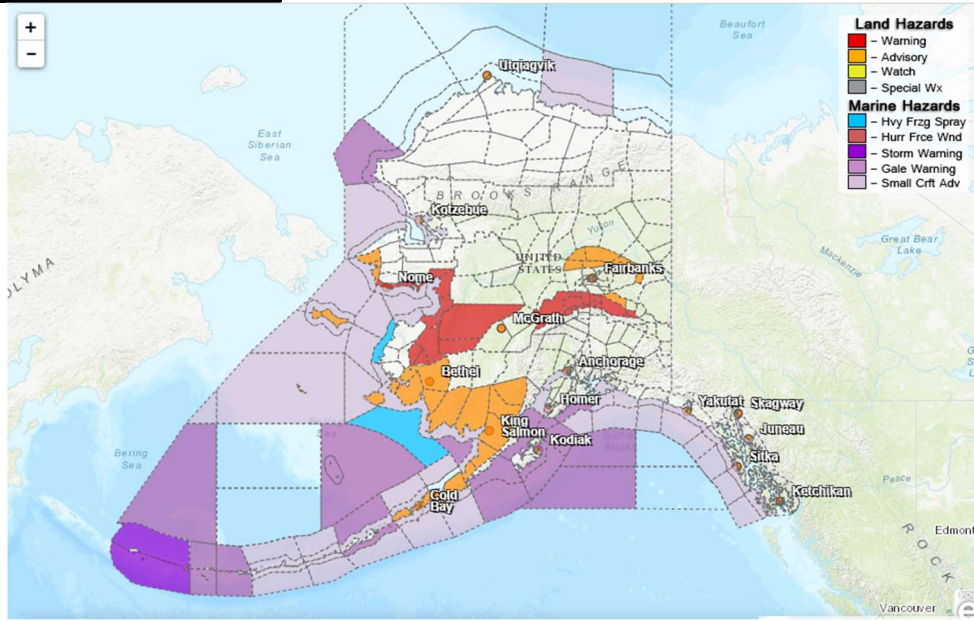


Travel in avalanche terrain is not recommended. Avoid being on or beneath all steep slopes.

- **Turnagain Pass** – Considerable above 1,000FT; Moderate below.
- **Valdez** – Moderate at all elevations.

- **Lower Yukon River and Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys** – in effect until 6am AKST Friday.
- **Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills** – in effect until 9am AKST Friday.

Winter Weather Advisory

- **Bristol Bay and the Alaska Peninsula** – in effect until 9pm AKST Thursday.
- **Kuskokwim Delta** – in effect until 9am AKST this morning.
- **Bering Strait Coast and St Lawrence Island** – in effect from Noon AKST Friday until Noon Sunday.

High Wind Warning

- **Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp, Northern Denali Borough** – in effect until 9am AKST Friday.
