Significant Issues:

South Tongass Fire Station Fire

The Governor has declared a state disaster emergency for Public Assistance for the Ketchikan Gateway Borough, in response to the Borough, City of Ketchikan, and City of Saxman local declaration and request for state assistance.

Alaska Rehearsal of Concept (ROC) Drill

This week, staff from the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management will be attending the ROC drill in Anchorage. Attendees include local, state, federal, volunteer and private sector agencies to discuss a repeat of a 1964 earthquake event with a focus on a full interagency response.

Riverwatch Training

Annual Riverwatch training today in participation with the River Forecast Center and the SEOC to coordinate spring breakup outlook. Kuskokwim and Yukon community calls are scheduled for next week, where communities will give updates on river ice conditions.

State of Alaska Department of Health (DOH)

The DOH stands ready to assist with all aspects of public health and, in the event of a public health emergency, is supported by the SEOC and other state departments as required.

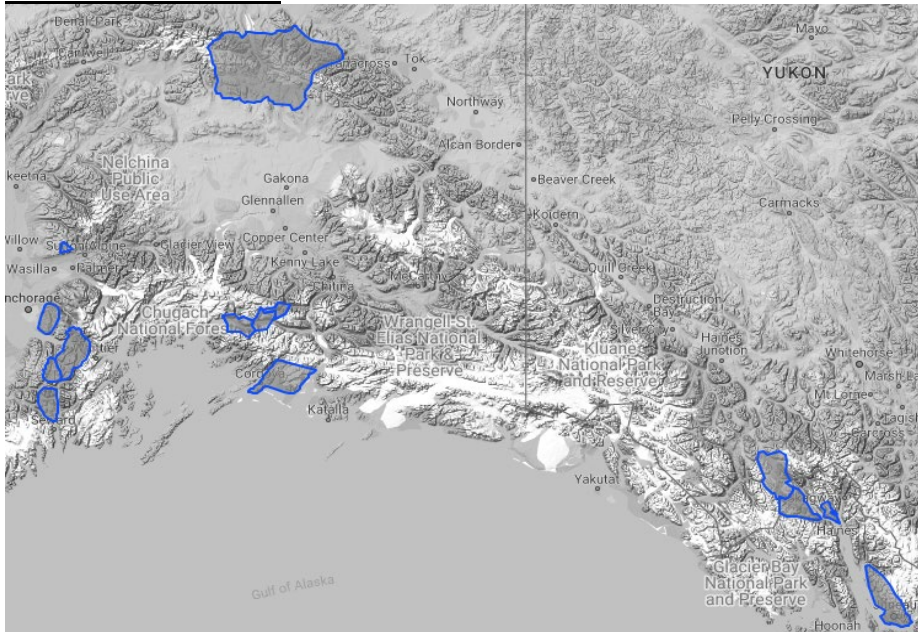

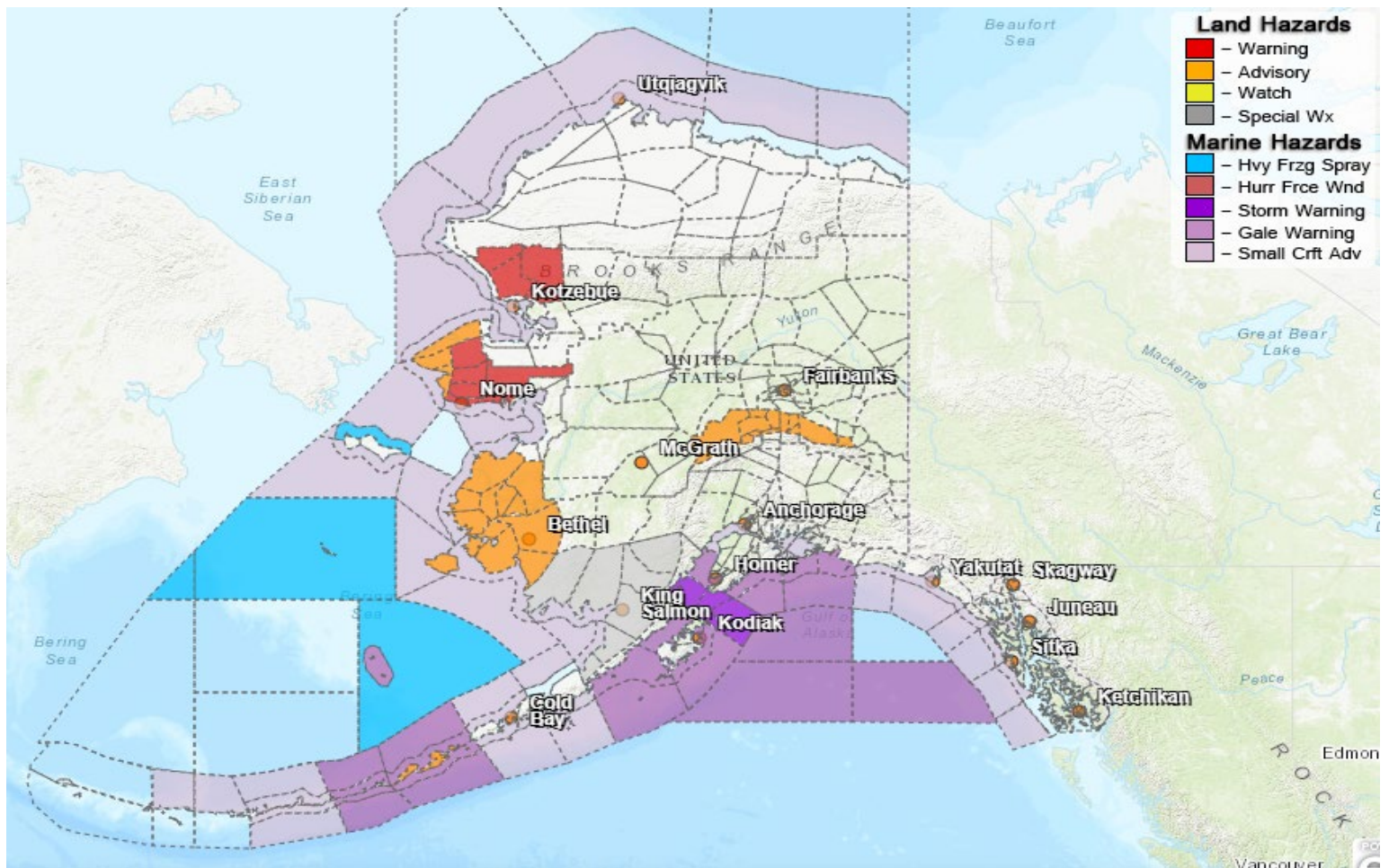
Avalanche Hazard
