Significant Issues:

Southcentral Sustained Cold – Natural Gas Concerns

Enstar Natural Gas, the southcentral natural gas supplier, advised the public that, due to unanticipated gas well problems and the sustained cold weather, natural gas supplies were being stretched and asked for voluntary conservation from the public. Enstar is asking the public to reduce home thermostat temperatures, etc. While still at “green,” the supply and demand are very close to “yellow.” SEOC is actively monitoring and remains in contact with all relevant agency partners.

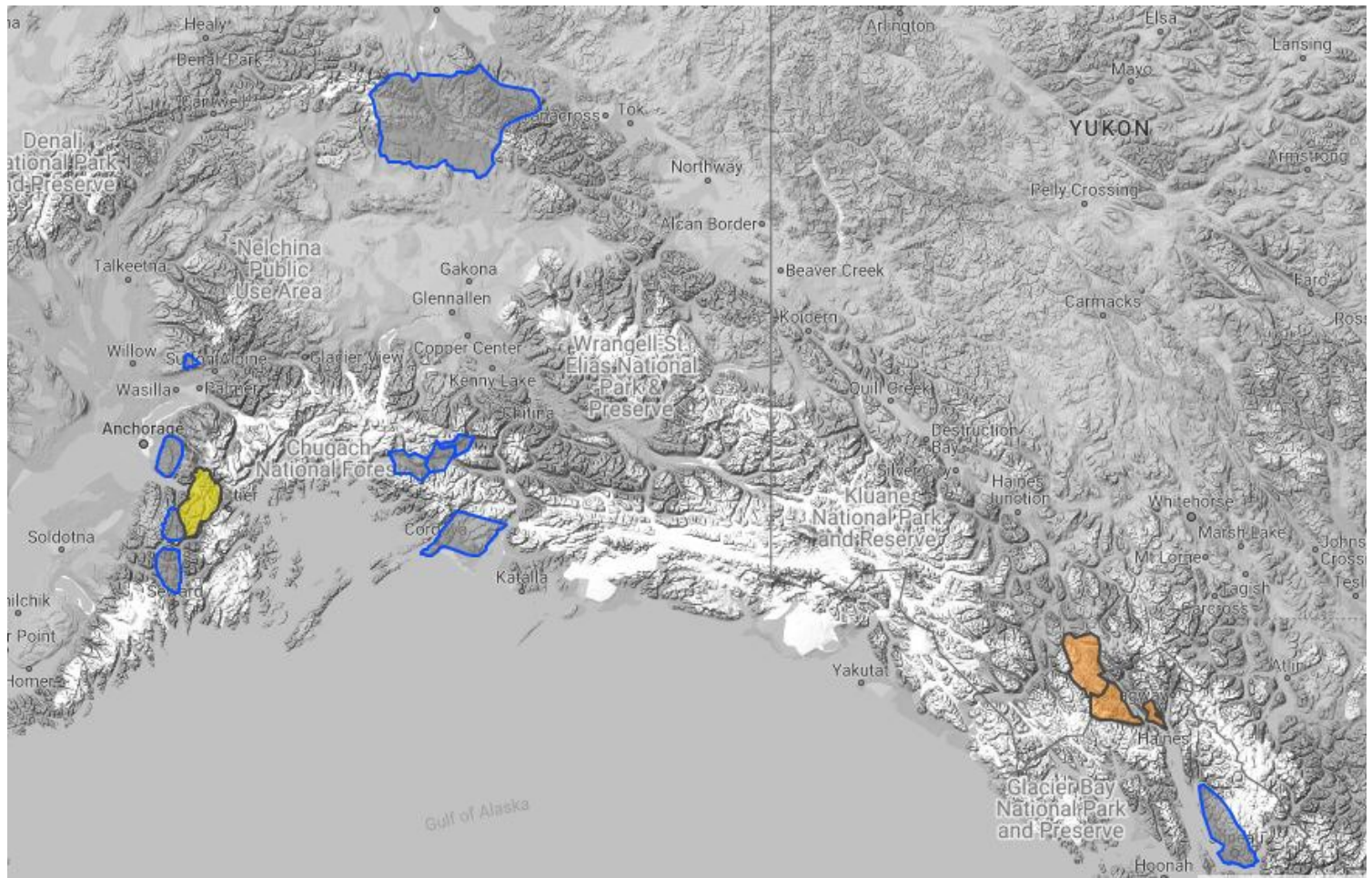

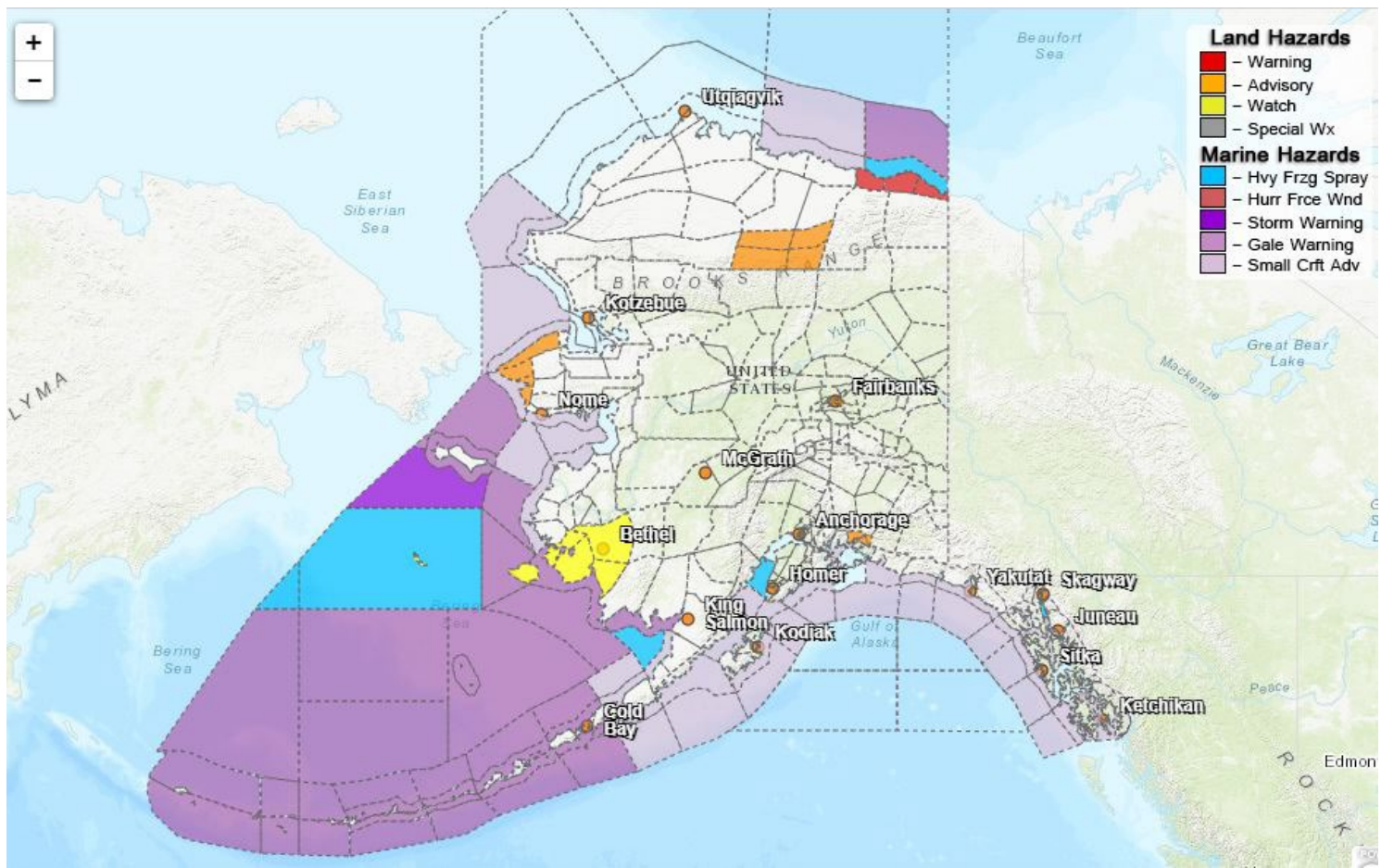
Avalanche Hazards:
