

#### **Significant Weather**



A blizzard warning is in effect for the Western Arctic coast, Chukchi Sea coast, Diomede, St. Lawrence Island, Baldwin Peninsula, Selawik Valley, and the Bering Strait coast through Friday, March 2. A high wind warning has been issued for Juneau Borough and northern Admiralty Island until 11 pm tonight.
