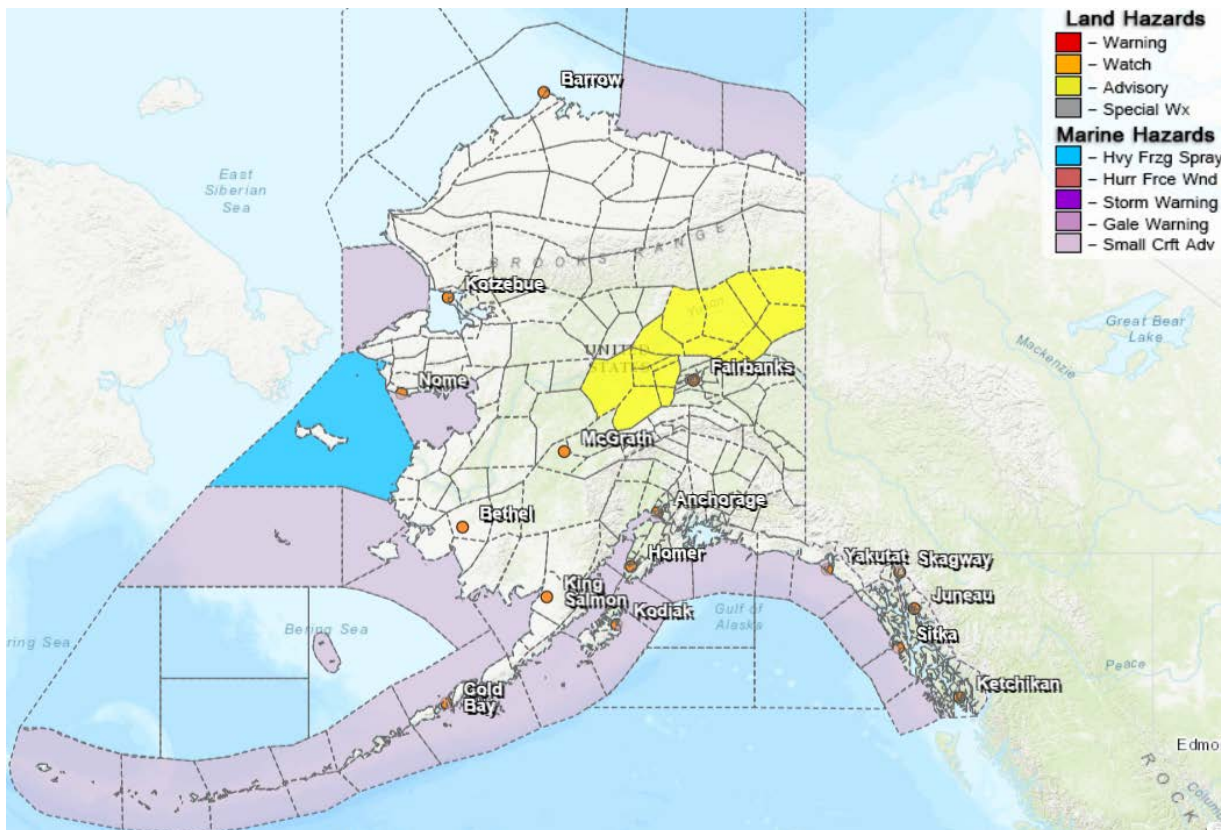

## **Avalanche Forecast**

**High:** Alpine areas around Turnagain Pass and Lutak (Haines)

**Considerable:** Areas below 2,500' on Turnagain Pass and Portage Valley, areas above 1,500' around Haines, and all areas around Hatcher Pass.

**Moderate:** Areas below 2,000' around Cordova and above 2,500' around Valdez.
