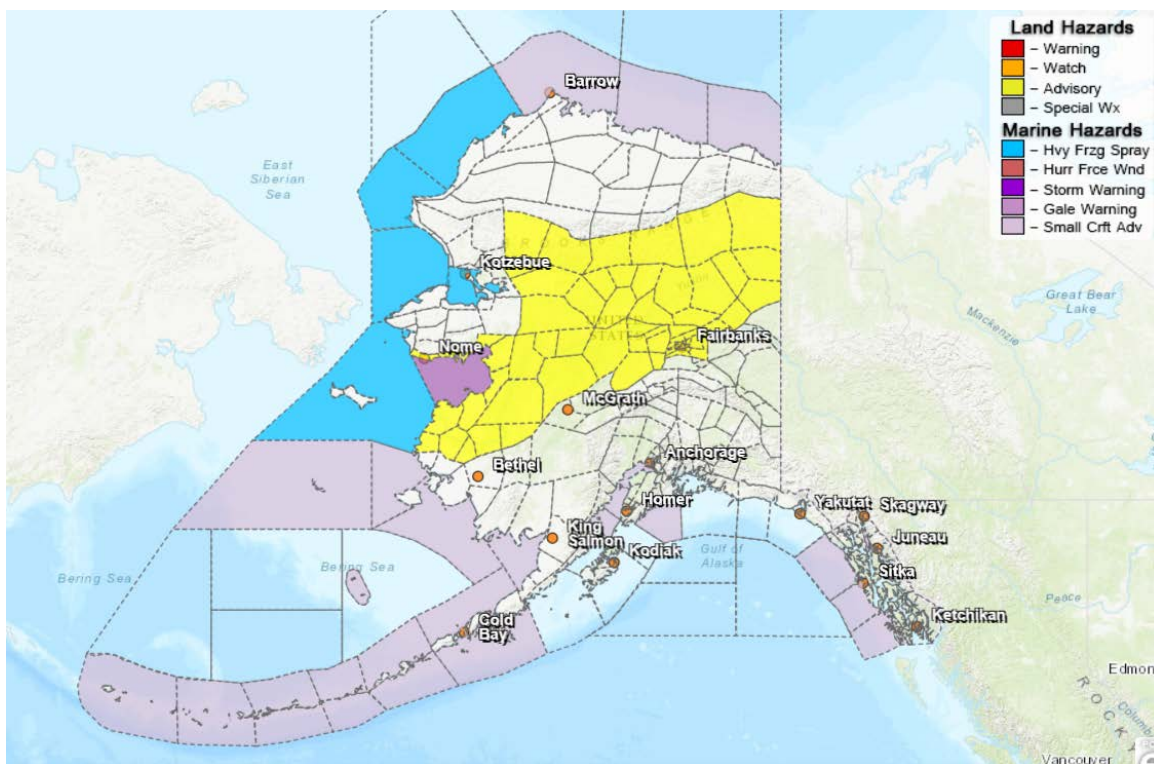

- Lower and Upper Koyukuk Valleys
- Middle Tanana Valley and the Central Interior

A high surf advisory is in effect for the following areas today:

- Yukon Delta
- Southern Seward Peninsula coast
- Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills

A winter weather advisory is in effect for the Southeastern Brooks Range and the Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys until 6 am Tuesday.

There are several small craft and freezing spray advisories for Alaskan waters today.
