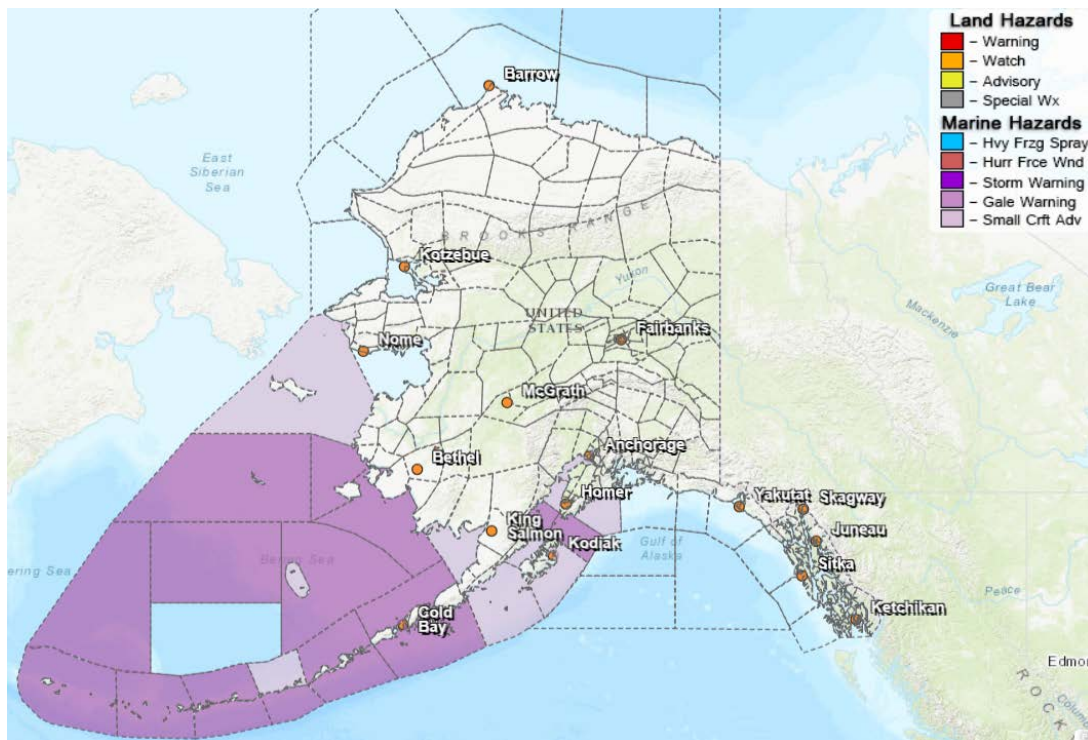

**River Watch and Spring Breakup:** The SEOC is monitoring flooding in Lower Kalskag on the Kuskokwim River. The SEOC is in contact with Upper and Lower Kalskag, Bethel Search and Rescue, and the National Weather Service following this development.

The Upper Yukon team launched to the Eagle area Sunday, May 6. For the Upper Yukon, Upper Yukon team reports shifting ice upstream of Eagle, intact but discolored ice downstream of Circle with some open leads.
