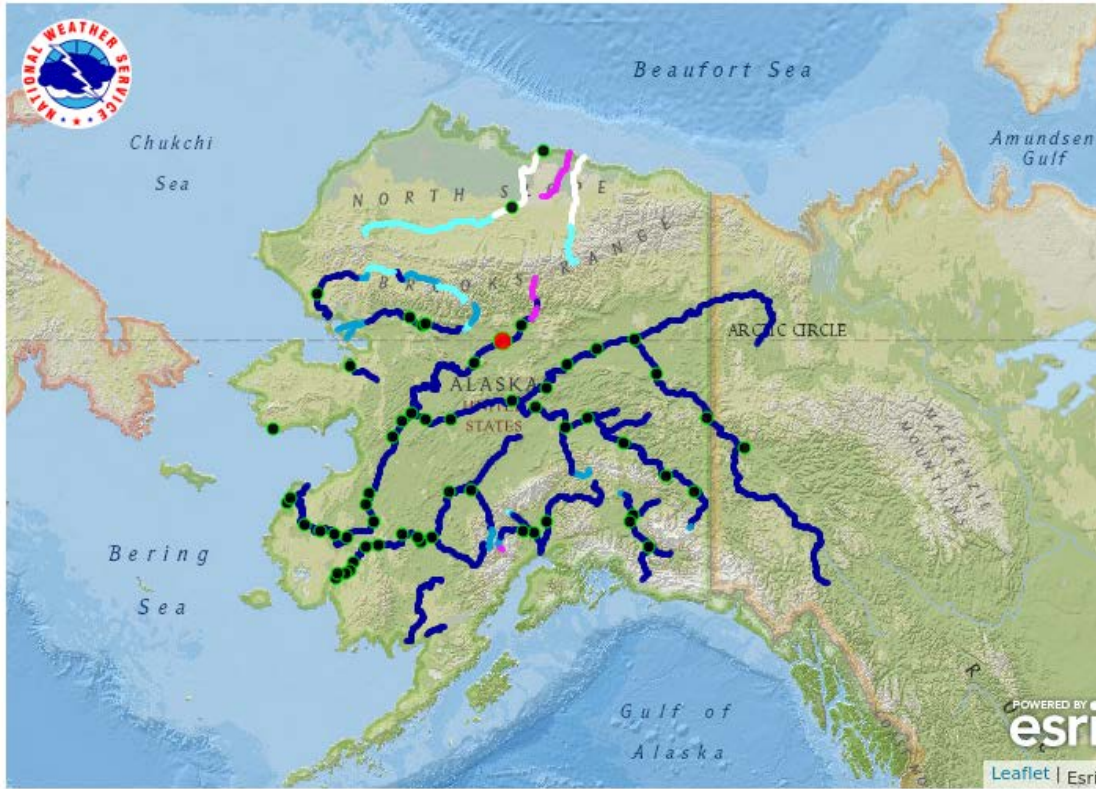

**Akiak Erosion**

The recent snowmelt in the highlands has caused high water on the Kuskokwim from Akiak to Kwethluk over the last week. This high water under velocity caused 40 – 45 feet of riverbank erosion in 1.5 hours on Friday afternoon. While there are no immediate threats to public or private structures or facilities, the acceleration in erosion is worrisome. The SEOC will continue work with the community to determine what state, federal, or other assistance can be provided to them to address this erosion.

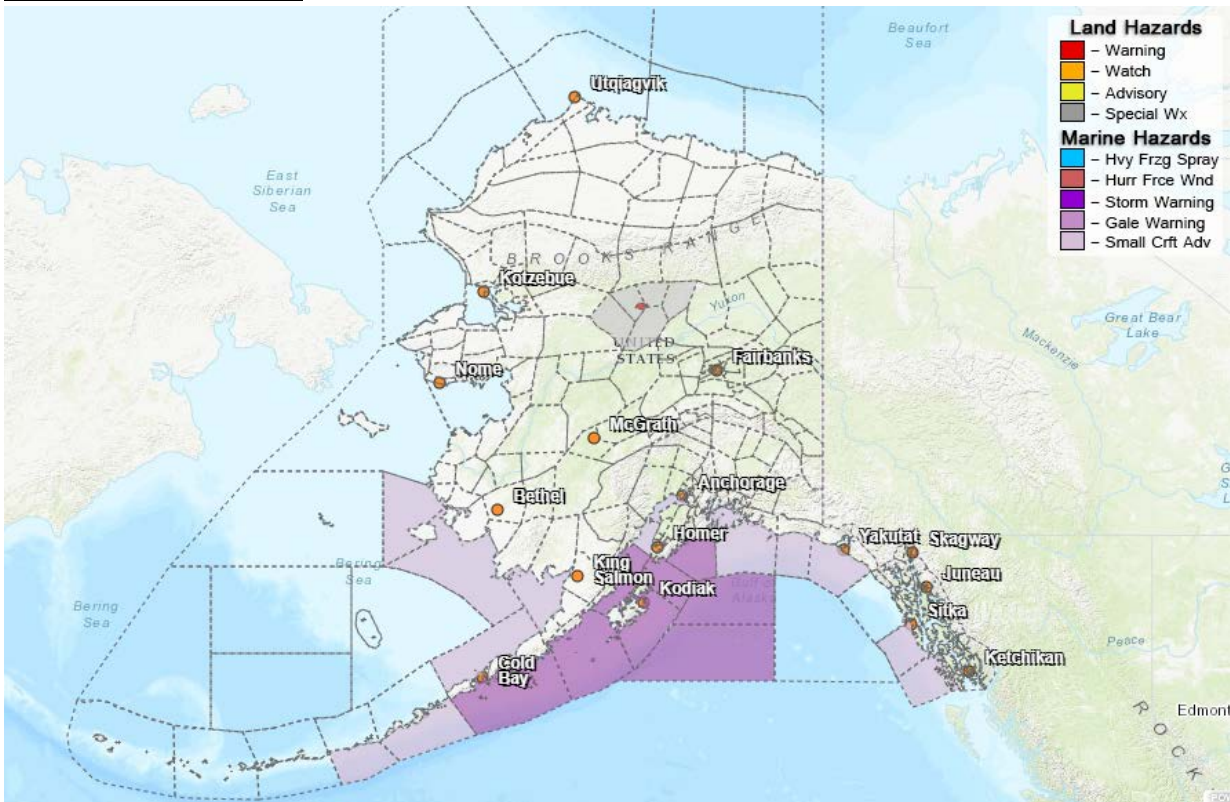
## APRFC Breakup Map - 22 May 2019 7:19:10 AM AKDT
