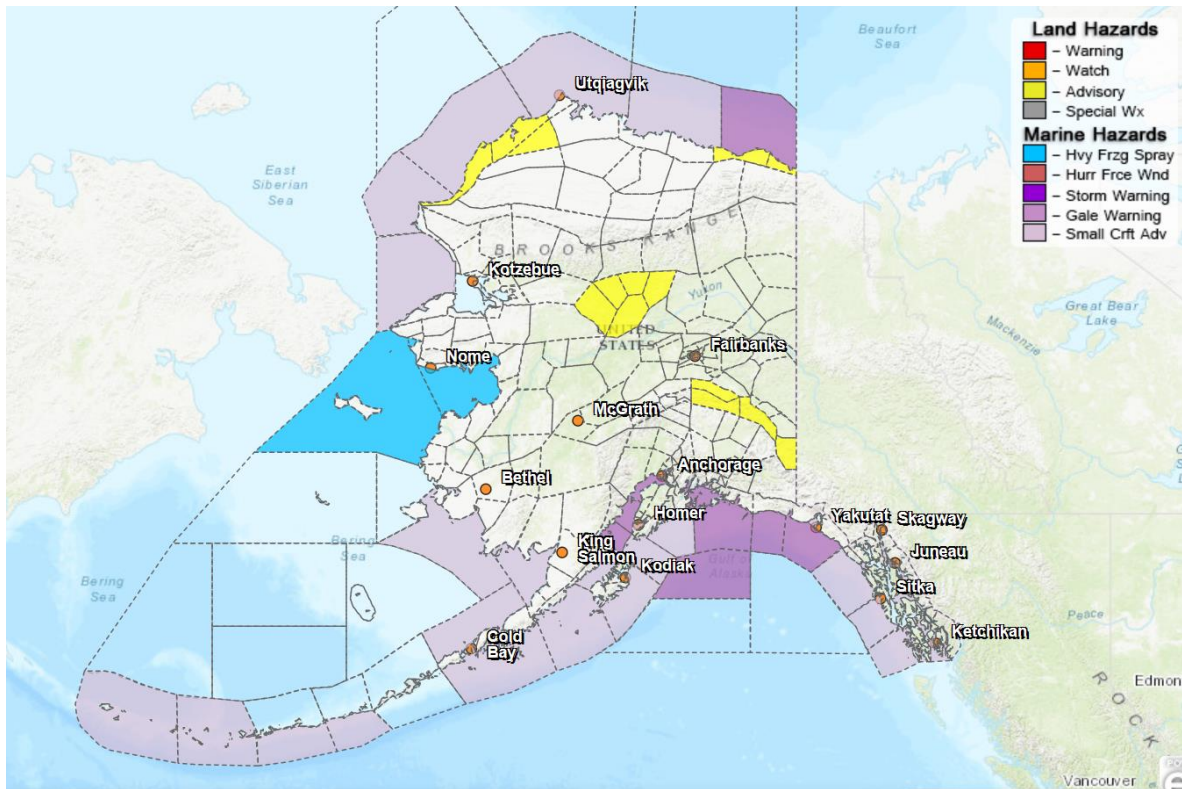
**Cook Inlet Earthquake (FEMA Declaration 4413-DR)**

The SEOC remains activated to Level 3. This is the 103<sup>rd</sup> day since the earthquake. FEMA command and general staff are still working out of the SEOC; a Joint Field Office (JFO) has not yet been set up. Yesterday the SEOC was contacted by the City Manager for Whittier wanted to discuss earthquake damage to several harbor facilities. Currently Whittier is not included in either the State declaration, or the federal declaration (the City is located within the Chugach Regional Education Attendance Area). We will follow up with State and FEMA Public Assistance Staff this week to determine how to proceed.
