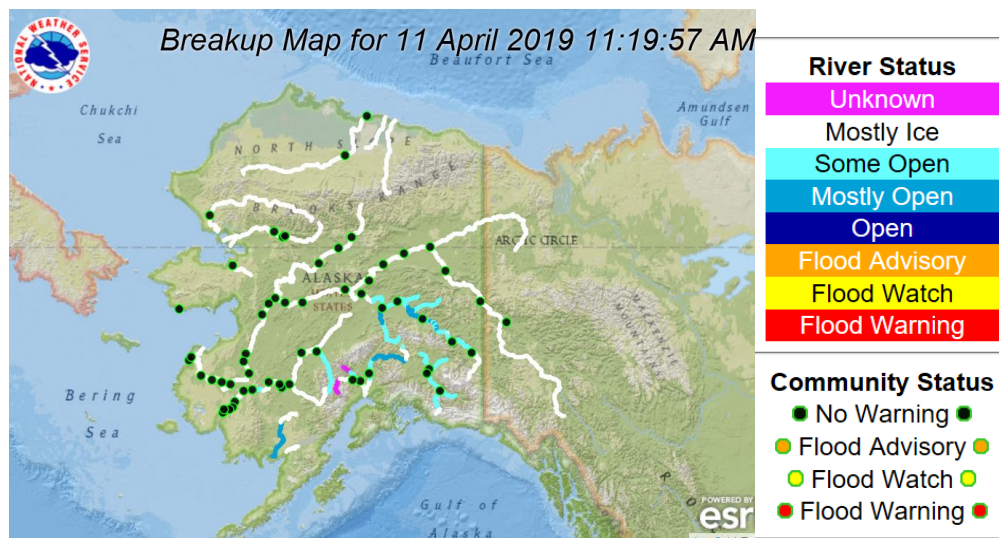
#### **Cook Inlet M7.1 Earthquake (FEMA Declaration 4413-DR)**

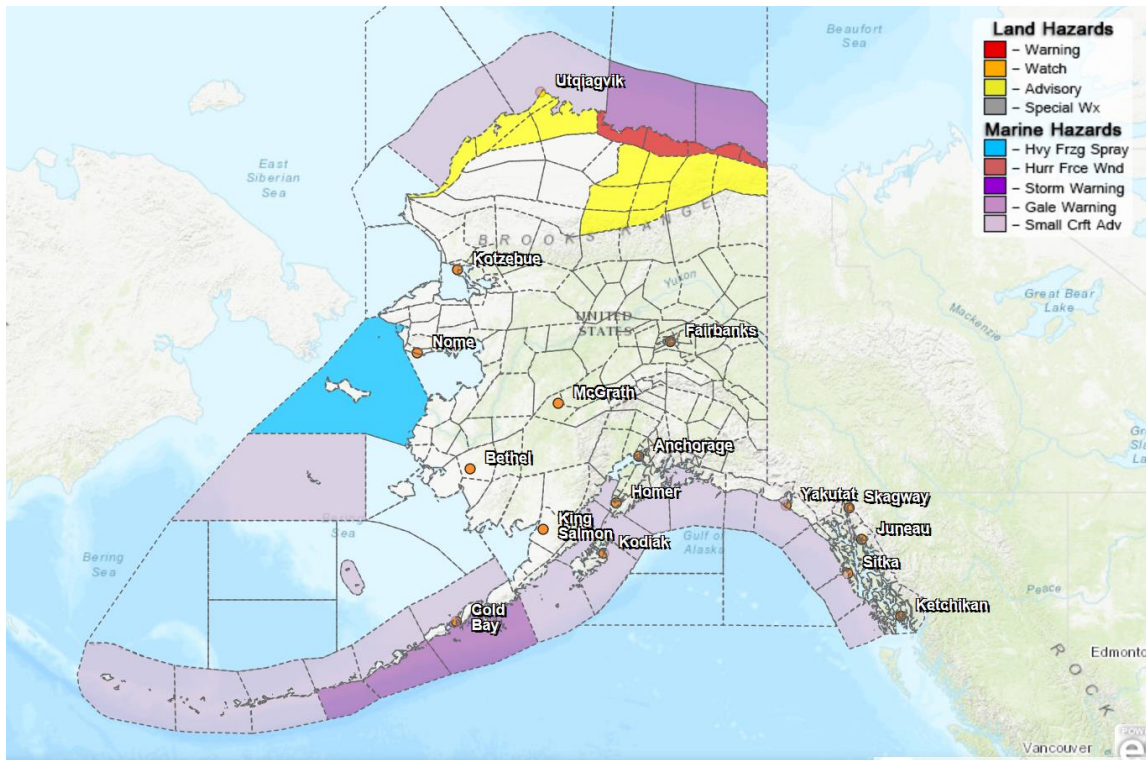
