High Water and Erosion

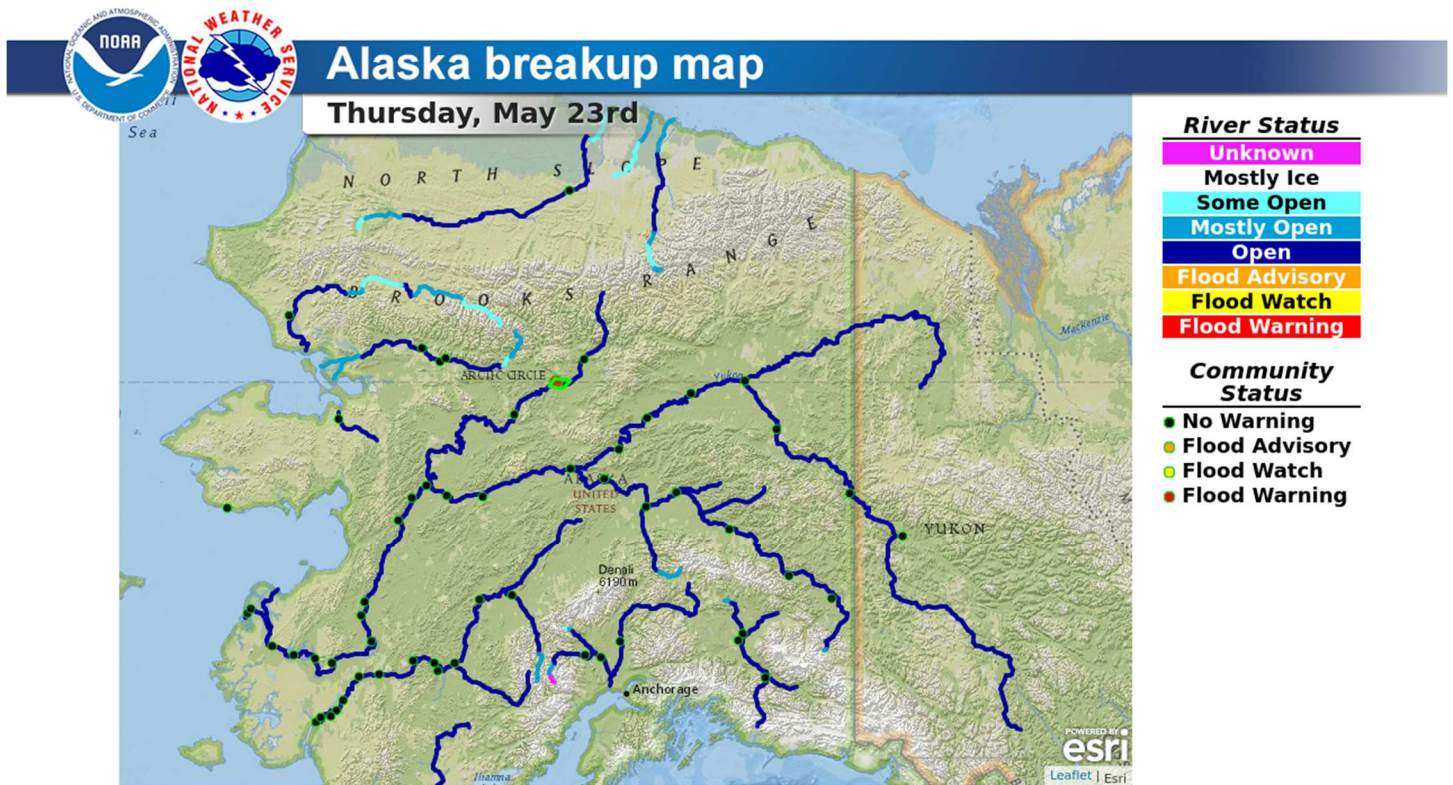

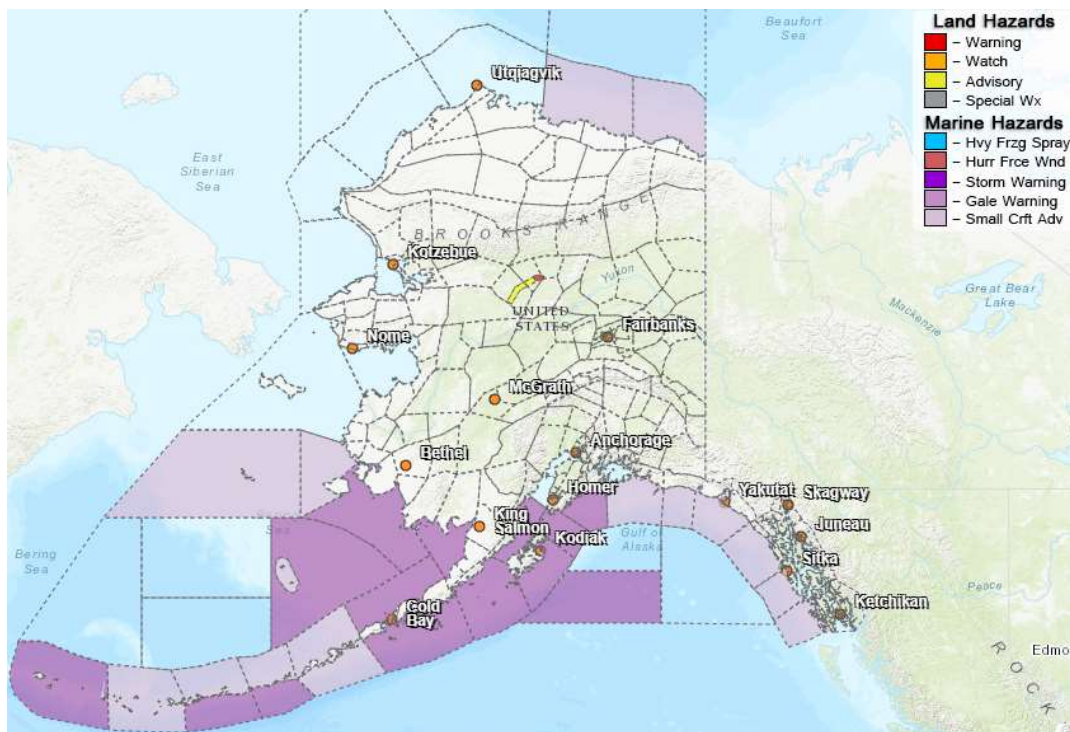
