### **DHS&EM OPERATIONS**

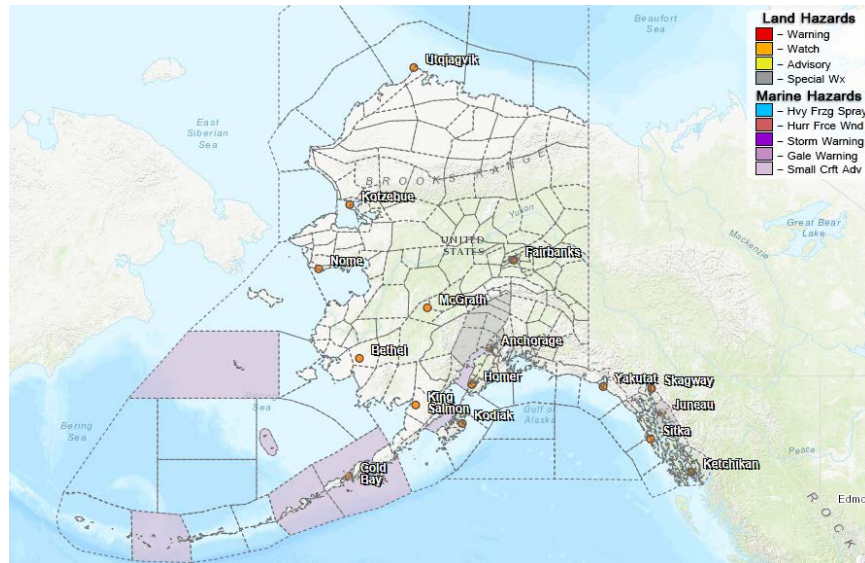
#### **Cook Inlet M7.1 Earthquake (FEMA Declaration DR-4413)**

DHS&EM, FEMA, and other federal agencies are managing the recovery efforts associated with the Cook Inlet M7.1 earthquake at the Joint Field Office (JFO) in Anchorage.

#### **Swan Lake Fire near Sterling**

SEOC was contacted Friday by the Logistics Section Chief on the Swan Lake Fire in Kenai near Sterling. The incident command for the fire is doing some contingency planning and inquired about traffic control resources available through the Alaska National Guard. SEOC provided the memorandum of understanding between State Forestry and the Guard for reference. SEOC advised the Alaska National Guard Joint Operations Center of the Fire's inquiry. SEOC will remain in close contact with the Fire's Incident Command and the Kenai Borough over the next few days.

### **Significant Weather**



A Special Weather Statement has been issued for rivers in the Matanuska and Susitna Valleys. Due to glacial melt bankfull river levels are expected and some minor overbank flooding of low lying areas is possible early next week.
