Significant Issues:

Diomede Power Restoration: Power was restored in Diomede Thursday afternoon. Additional repairs are expected to continue throughout the weekend. There are no requests for additional State assistance at this time. SEOC will continue to monitor the situation and maintain regular contact with the community.


Air Quality Index (AQI) Advisories
