THREAT LEVEL CHANGES: SEOC LEVEL 1 – ROUTINE OPERATIONS

<u>Significant Issues:</u> Kenai Peninsula Borough storm event: The SEOC received a local emergency declaration from KPB, dated December 6, that includes a local declaration from the City of Seldovia, each seeking public and individual assistance, emergency resources, and other assistance for storm related power outages, and potential flooding. Power has been restored to all but a handful of homes and there are no requests for immediate assistance at this time. The SEOC is working with KPB, Seldovia, and the local power utility to determine what assistance the State can provide.

Travel Alerts and Conditions

Homer: Roads closed due to flooding: Old Sterling at Anchor River, Anchor Point Road, North Fork Rd at south fork of the Anchor River mile 15 and Kachemak Drive near Northern Enterprises. Watch for overtopping of Sterling Highway at mile 160-161


