

# Significant Weather:



Winter Weather Advisories have been Issued for Denali until noon today and Southeastern Brooks Range until 12:00 pm tomorrow.

High Wind Warning for Cape Decision to Salisbury Sound Coastal Area; Inner Channels from Kupreanof Island to Etolin Island, the southern Inner Channels and the southeast Gulf Coast including Ketchikan, Craig, Hydaburg, and Metlakatla until noon today, and for Eastern Baranof Island and Southern Admiralty Island until 3:00 pm today.

Wind Chill Advisories remain in effect through Thursday evening and into Friday afternoon for much of Alaska with a Wind Chill Warning issued for Northeastern Brooks Range through 6:00 pm Friday evening.

A Winter Storm Warning remains in effect for Taiya Inlet and Klondike Highway, Haines Borough and Lynn Canal, including the cities of Skagway and Haines, until 9:00 pm tonight and for Eastern Chichagof Island and Glacier Bay, Juneau Borough and Northern Admiralty Island, Salisbury Sound to Cape Fairweather Coastal Area until 6:00 pm.
