

Significant Weather:



A Winter Weather Advisory for very cold wind chills and blowing snow is in effect until noon for the Northeastern Brooks Range.

Winter Weather Advisories are in effect today for Saint Lawrence Island, the Bering Strait Coast, he Baldwin Peninsula, and Selawik Valley.

Wind Chill Advisories are in effect today for the Arctic and Beaufort Sea Coasts.

A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for snow and blowing snow from this evening through Tuesday for Kodiak Island.

A Winter Storm Watch for possible blizzard conditions is in effect for Thompson Pass on Tuesday.

Winter Storm Watches and Winter Weather Advisories are in effect from late tonight and Tuesday for much of the Southeast Panhandle.

Avalanche Hazards

Cordova: Avalanche Hazard is Considerable above 2,000 feet, and Moderate between 1,000 and 2,000 feet.

Valdez: Avalanche Hazard is Considerable above 2,000 feet and Moderate below 2,000 feet.

Turnagain Pass: Avalanche Hazard is Considerable above 1,000 feet.
