# Significant Issues

# Chignik 7.8 Earthquake

Local damage assessments continue in several communities affected by the M7.8 earthquake last week. DOT&PF has inspected transportation and dock facilities in several communities. Aftershocks from the earthquake will continue to occur for several weeks or months.

# **Delta River Flooding**

DOT&PF continues to develop plans to address the flooding of Spengler Road, near Delta. The National Weather Service has installed a temporary hydrograph station on the road. For the past several days, the water level on the road has remained between 8 and 10 inches deep. When the water level drops below the road, DOT&PF will assess any damage to the roadway.

# Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

#### 2020 Fire Season

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 1.

Wildland fire totals for 2020:

Total Fires = 319

Total Acres = 180,197

There are currently 33 active fires with 0 fires currently staffed.



# **Significant Weather:**




Flood Watches are in effect for the Central Interior, Middle Tanana Valley, and Denali through late tonight due to heavy rain.
