## **Significant Issues:**

#### **Great Sitkin Volcano:**

At 2000 hrs. yesterday the Alaska Volcano Observatory (AVO) notified the SEOC that Great Sitkin volcano, near Adak, had an increase of local earthquake activity with the potential for eruption. AVO moved the volcano to alert status Orange/Watch. The SEOC notified the Adak City Manager who began direct observation of the volcano. At 2112 hrs., Adak's City Manager contacted the SEOC reporting that the volcano had erupted with a visible ash plume. SEOC contacted AVO and the National Weather Service and advised them of the active eruption. Those agencies subsequently issued an eruption alert for the volcano, moving its status to Red/Warning. The eruption was a short-duration event, with ash to 15,000 feet and with prevailing winds, no direct ash fall in Adak was anticipated.

# Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic:

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC continues to support statewide response to COVID-19.


