

## Significant Weather:



Winter storm watches are in effect Friday and Saturday for all of Southeast Alaska. A strong system is expected to move over the entire Panhandle on Friday. This system may produce 4 to 18 inches or more of snow by New Years Day, then slowly move south through Sunday with additional accumulations likely.


Winter storm watches are also in effect for Denali and the Eastern Alaska Range through Sunday.

Wind chill advisories are in effect for the Northwest coast from St. Lawrence Island to Wainwright through late tomorrow morning.

A winter weather advisory is in effect for the Kuskokwim Delta through 6 am Friday.
