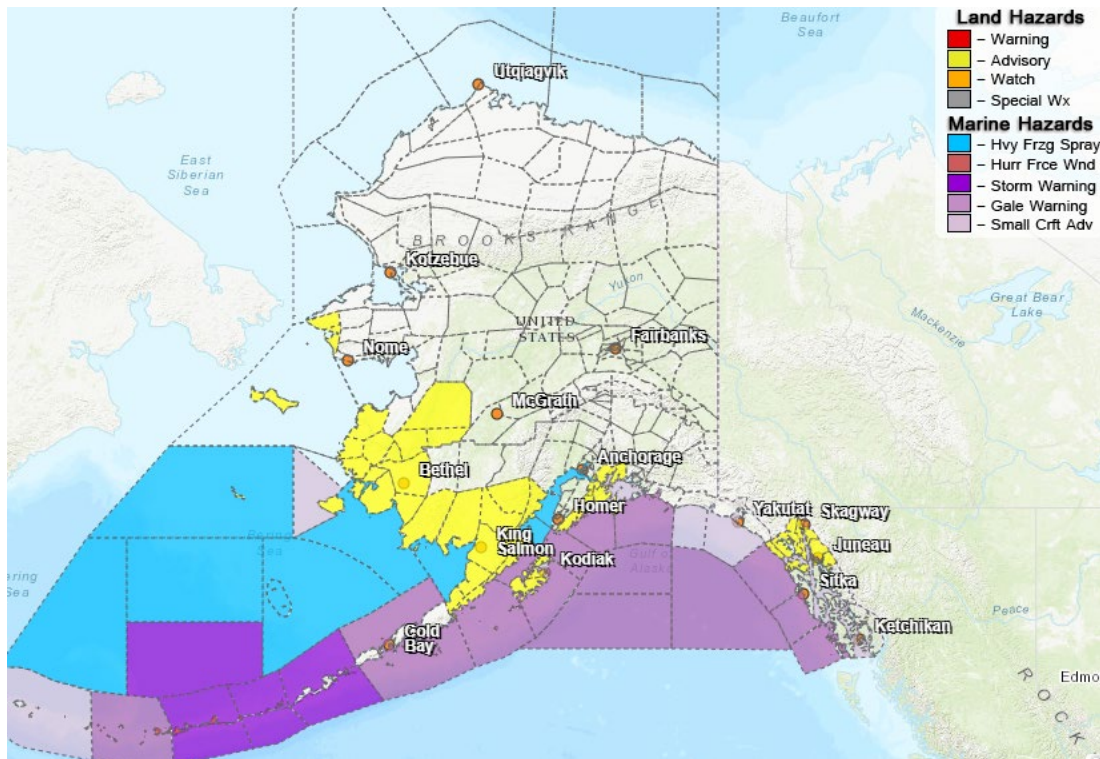

Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for Glacier Bay; Eastern Chichagof Island; Cape Fairweather to Lisianski Strait; City and Borough of Juneau; Haines Borough and Klukwan; City of Hyder; Western Prince William Sound; Kodiak Island; Bristol Bay; St. Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast into Friday.

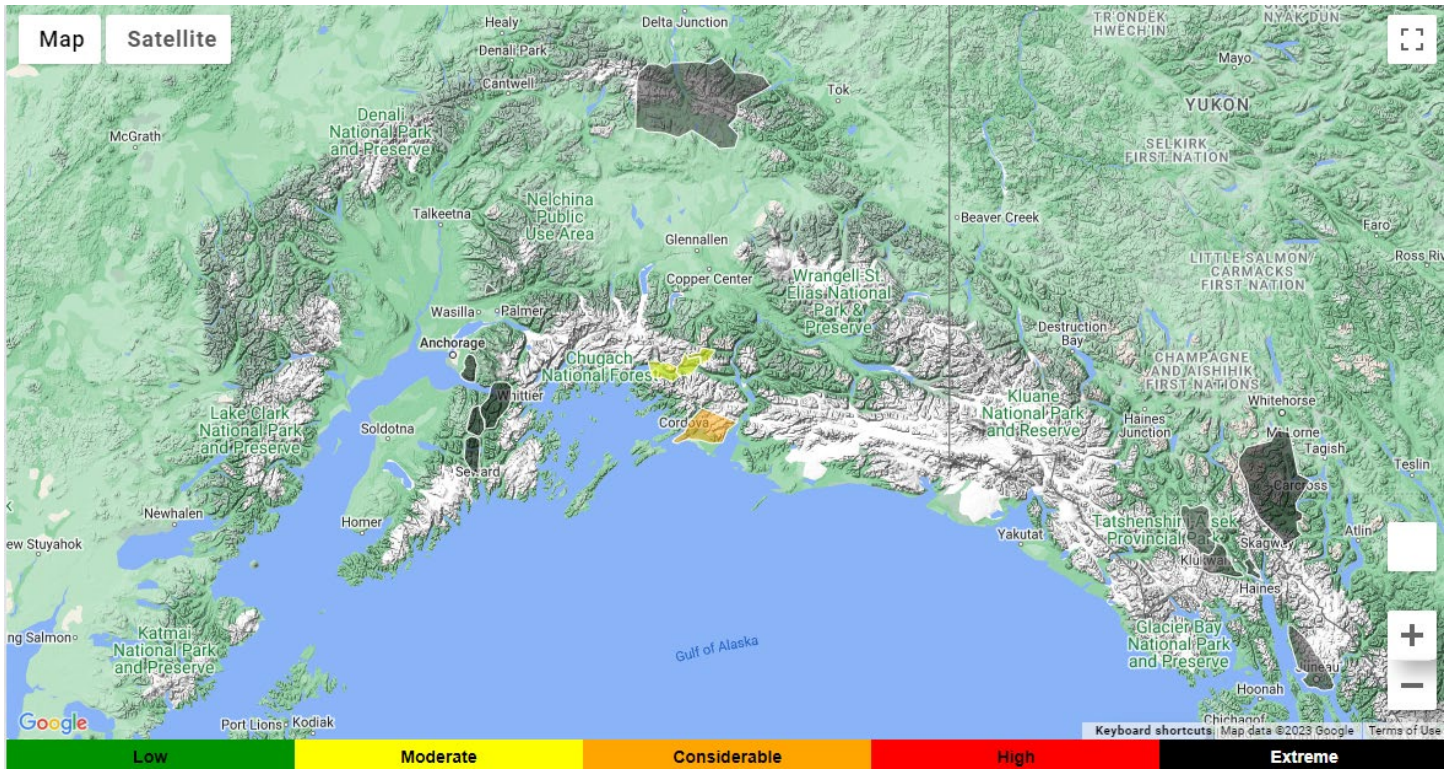
A high wind warning is effect for the Central Aleutians until 7pm Thursday for winds of 35 to 55mph with gusts up to 85mph.

Blizzard Warning issued for the Pribilof Islands beginning this afternoon until 1:00 pm Friday afternoon for snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches, winds gusting to 60 mph..

Wind Chill Advisories have been issued for Yukon Delta; Lower Yukon Valley from 6:00 pm this evening to midnight AKST Friday Night

### **Avalanche Forecast:**



- Moderate advisory level at elevations above 1,000 ft and low advisory level below 1,000 ft. in Turnagain Pass
- Considerable advisory level above 2,000 ft, moderate advisory level from 1,000 to 2,000ft and low advisory level below 1,000 ft near Cordova.
- **Moderate advisory** level at all elevations in Valdez area.
- Low Advisory level at all elevations in the Haines area.
- **Moderate advisory level at all elevations in Hatcher Pass area.**
