Significant Issues:

Whittier Fire

Just before noon on July 4, 2023, the city of Whittier had a fire that broke out at the fuel dock. Fire and EMS units from Whittier, Girdwood, and surrounding communities responded, as well as the Coast Guard. The tunnel was shut down to allow the emergency crews access from noon to shortly after the blaze was put out around 5:00pm.

Two men who were on a boat in the vicinity sustained moderate injuries in the fire, one boat sank, and the dock sustained substantial damage. The dock is closed temporarily, until an official assessment can be completed. The tunnel is back to normal operation today.

2023 Spring Floods Disaster

SEOC will begin travel for the Joint Preliminary Damage Assessments with the Federal Emergency Management Agency, July 10.


