Significant Issues:

Shishaldin Volcano

At 7:56 am on Tuesday July 18, the Alaska Volcano observatory upgraded the Shishaldin Volcano activity level to RED/WARNING due to an intensified eruption. A rapidly growing ash cloud was observed and drifting SSE. Cloud height is undetermined at this time but could be between 20 to 30 thousand feet above sea level. No communities are expected to be impacted at this time, SEOC will be making community calls to notify communities nearby.

2023 Spring Floods Disaster

State Public & Individual Assistance, Small Business Administration, and Federal Emergency Management Agency teams will continue the Joint Preliminary Damage Assessments this week in Crooked Creek, Pilot Station, Kwethluk, Russian Mission, and Emmonak.
