



Disaster Supply Kit for Pets

Preparing Your Pets for Emergencies

- Always have a collar with ID, license, and rabies tags
- Store current shot and health records in a waterproof container, such as a freezer bag
- Food and water bowls with enough food and water for seven days. Remember: keep the food in a watertight container
- Manual can opener for canned food
- Plastic bags to dispose of pet droppings and other waste
- Current photo of your pet
- Pet carrier with plenty of bedding
- Leash
- Toys
- Medications
- First Aid kit
- Grooming supplies
- Paper towels/wet wipes
- Flashlight and spare batteries
- Cat litter and litter box
