

State of Alaska Individual Assistance

Applicants to the state individual assistance program must also apply to FEMA, and accept an SBA loan if eligible. Applicants who do not register for all federally funded programs will not be eligible to receive assistance awards from the state. State of Alaska Individual Assistance awards will be determined during the reconsideration process following each Applicants final determination from FEMA and SBA.

Insurance

Insurance is the first line of defense following a disaster. If you have insurance, file the claim immediately.



FEMA

You must register with FEMA to be eligible for state individual assistance. Complete the FEMA Disaster Assistance process including appeals and receive a final determination notification from FEMA



SBA

You must accept an SBA loan if eligible to be reconsidered for state individual assistance. To receive state individual assistance, you are required to accept the full loan amount. You will need to provide your loan processing letter or denial letter.
